




In our study of The Dead Sea Scrolls this week we will be looking at the connections between St. John the Baptist, St. John the Apostle and the sacrament of baptism. How baptism makes us each a child of God. We invite everyone in our parish to attend these incredible talks. They will be streamed off of the FORMED.org website. If you are unable to come, you can view them at home on that website. We will meet on Thursdays at 9:00 and 5:30 pm for a 30-minute talk and discussion. The dates are as follows: January 27, February 3, 10, 17, 24, March 3. Dr. John Bergsma will be leading the talk with Fr. Dave Pivonka. There is no workbook that goes along with it, however you can order the book by Dr. John Bergsma "Jesus Christ and the Dead Sea Scrolls." The Dead Sea Scrolls will help us to encounter the Essene community and their life and will help us to be models of holiness. Finally, the study will draw us to encounter Christ in a deeper way.

The season of Lent will begin on Wednesday, March 2<sup>nd</sup>. We will again be doing the Mary's Mantle Consecration throughout Lent. It is a consecration for heaven's help. Forty parishioners will be needed to sign up for it to be a success. It is a 40-day retreat for Heaven's help. Each day during Lent a different person is scheduled to do a light fast with bread and water or 3 light meals for the day. All of the other people pray for the intentions of the person fasting. We also ponder on amazing daily excerpts from the "Mary's Mantle Consecration" book which we will order here at the parish. If you would like to join us in this most holy season of Lent by consecrating yourself to Mary, there is a sign-up sheet in the back of church. We will also be united by a daily email from the office where it will be noted who we are praying for and the meditation on the virtue for the day. Consecrating yourself to Mary's Mantle is powerful as is fasting. If we get 40 people to join in this exciting pilgrimage, we will all each have only one day to fast. Prior to the beginning of Lent, a schedule will be given to all and we will begin with a short introductory video on the consecration on Tuesday, February 2 at 9:00 am and 5:30 pm. You can also do this from home with us. If you don't have an email, I will just make a copy of the fasting schedule and give it to those people that can't join in person. There will also be videos here at the parish each week of Lent on Thursdays that go along with the consecration. If you need more information, please call the office at 423-1251. We will meet on Tuesday, March 1st and then the following Thursdays...March 10, 17, 24, 31, April 7 & 14. The videos are available at QueenofPeaceMedia.com.as well. We at the parish encourage anyone who has many intentions to pray for, to join us. Prayer is powerful!

How does God speak to me? Have you ever wondered how God may be speaking to you? Perhaps you are waiting to hear a loud, booming voice come from the heavens to tell you what to do or which way to go. While this isn't completely out of the question, God often takes a much subtler approach. In 1 Kings, we have the account of the Prophet Elijah standing at the entrance of a cave, waiting for the Lord to appear. As he waits, he encounters a strong, violent wind, a powerful earthquake, and a consuming fire, yet God was not revealing Himself in any of those powerful examples. Finally, as Elijah waited, he heard a soft, quiet whisper. At that, he knelt to the ground and prayed. God often speaks to us, not in grand and impressive ways, but in the silence. When we can still our hearts, that's when we begin to hear His voice, calling us into relationship and to follow Him. Sometimes that invitation is to follow the Lord as one who lovingly serves others in the priesthood. 
