


We will be sharing a program "No Greater Love" by Dr. Edward Sri. It is a biblical walk through Christ's passion. Dr. Sri will take us on a journey to the Holy Land and Christ's journey to the cross. 

PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

The Lamb of God

In the Mass, before entering into communion, we sing "Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us." Unfortunately, this verse, like many parts of the Mass, can become routine. There is a rich depth to this phrase, though, as we see in the pages of the New Testament.

John the Baptist, as he was standing at the River Jordan, once said to his disciples: "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:26). This statement, which, incidentally, the priest says while he holds the host over the chalice, is a powerful confession. At the altar we also make a confession—this host that looks like thin bread, is God's Lamb. But what does that mean?

In the story of the Israelites in Egypt, God sent his tenth plague, the Angel of Death, against Pharaoh and his people to slay their first-born children. The Israelites, meanwhile, by placing the blood of sacrificed lambs on their doorposts, escaped the danger. The feast of Passover, which commemorates this event, was what Jesus and His disciples celebrated at the Last Supper. Christ, as the slain Lamb of God, sacrificed Himself on the Cross. It is the Blood of Jesus, signed over the doorpost of our hearts, that saves us from the experience of sin's death but also blesses us with the promise of the Resurrection after our physical death.

The last book of the Bible, Revelation, reveals a marriage that is to follow after the Resurrection; a marriage between the Church and the Lamb, who sits upon His throne. This scene which John the Apostle was able to see in vision, is something that we all hope to see in the Kingdom of Heaven. It is also something that we see humbly hidden in the Eucharist. In a sense, when we gaze upon the host and chalice, we are gazing into eternity, gazing into the victory of Christ, who is our Lamb of Sacrifice. Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world...grant us peace.
