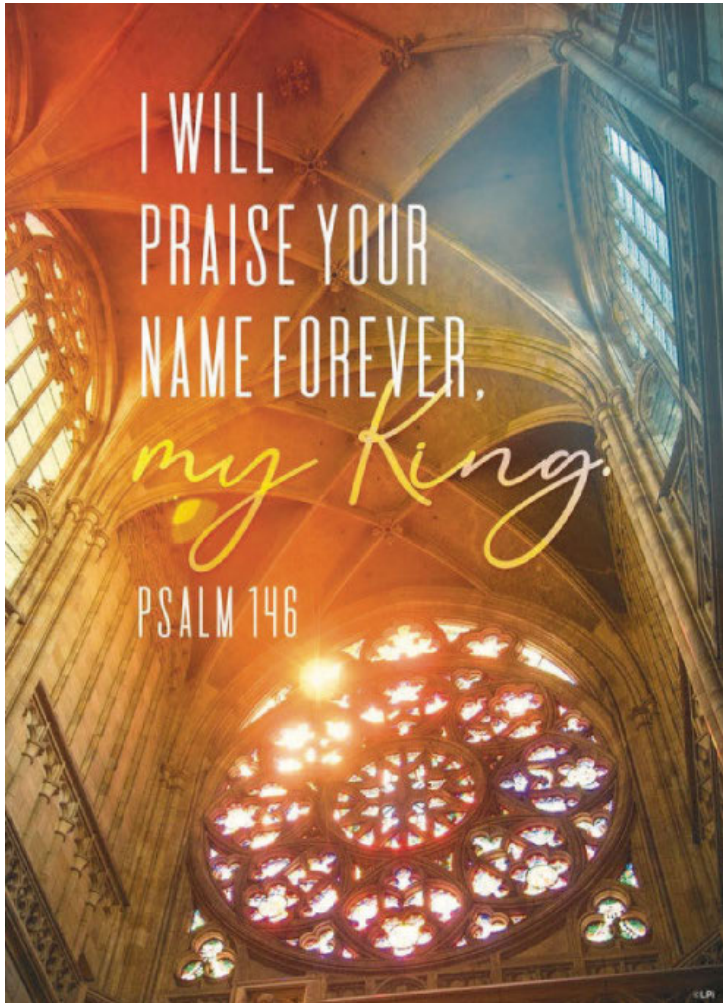

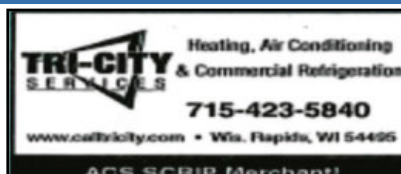

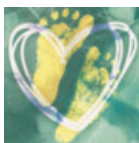

PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

May is a month dedicated to the honor of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In the Church, there are three different ranks of veneration, namely *latria*, *dulia* and *hyperdulia*.

Latria essentially means "adoration." This level of veneration is reserved for God alone. We approach our Creator in worship.

Dulia, is a veneration that we pay to the saints. We do not "adore" or "worship" them (they are only creatures after all); instead we hold them in great respect. They are the heroes whose love of God defined their lives.

The third form of veneration, **hyperdulia**, comes from the merging of the two words "hyper," meaning "over" or "above," and "dulia." This level of respect is reserved for one saint and one saint only: The Blessed Mother.

At the Annunciation, when God approached Mary through the angel Gabriel, He invited her to enter into His Plan of Salvation in a way that was totally unique, completely unlike the role of any other creature. Her mission had a dignity so far above the mission of all the saints combined that we have a respect that is far above the veneration we have for them. There is something "hyper" about it. When Mary said "yes" to being the mother of Jesus she said that "yes" for me, she said that "yes" for you. In this month of May, we approach this Blessed Lady with a joy that is rooted in a personal gratitude.



O loving Mother of our Redeemer, gate of heaven, star of the sea, Hasten to aid thy fallen people who strive to rise once more. Thou who brought forth thy holy Creator, all creation wond'ring, Yet remainest ever Virgin, taking from Gabriel's lips that joyful "Hail!": be merciful to us sinners.

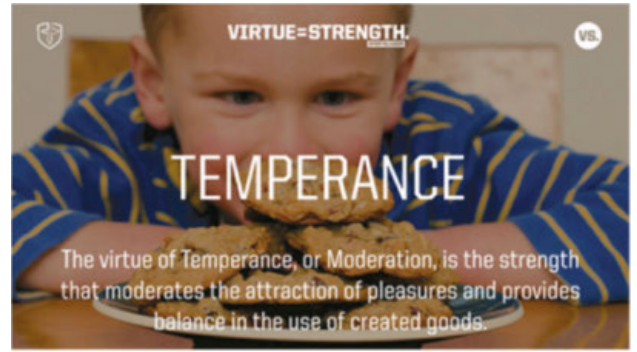
