

PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Dear Friends in Christ,

This past week I spent a few days at the Shrine of Our Lady in Guadalupe attending a conference for canon and civil lawyers. I try to attend this conference each year. It was three years ago last Sunday that I finished my license in Canon Law at The Catholic University of America in Washington, DC. After depositing my thesis (a research paper



that I wrote on the methods and forms of evidence in trials), I had to pass the "comprehensive examination" which is somewhat akin to passing the bar for civil lawyers. It was a nerve-wracking experience but I passed and did well. In the month leading up to this exam, my study group would meet daily for about 3 hours of review and preparation. That being said, I still like learning and so I am grateful to be able to attend these continuing education conferences.

Now, changing gears, last week I said I try not to talk about money in my bulletin column and yet I spoke about the "free money" that is the scrip program. I am breaking my own rule again this week to give an update on the "Inspired by the Spirit" campaign. As of a few days ago, OLQH Parish has just over \$10,000 to go to reach our goal. This is an enormous achievement. In addition to being so close to reaching our goal, the parish received an update that we have over \$77,000 already in our savings account at St. Ambrose Financial Services, Inc. from your generous support of the campaign. Our Diocesan Annual Appeal for 2022–2023 is completed and paid in full. If you have yet to participate in the campaign, please consider it. With the annual appeal complete, even more of your funds will stay in the parish and we are so very close to our goal. Let's make this the last time I say that we are under the goal.

OLQH Parish is in an excellent financial position at this time and that is all due to your generosity. Later this fall, the parish will distribute the annual financial report for the 2021–2022 fiscal year. You'll notice quite a difference in its appearance and contents this year. In the discussions that took place throughout the diocese for the Synod on Synodality, a common theme was a desire for increased transparency in parishes and the diocese, especially regarding finances. As pastor, I will do all I can do to make sure our parish finances are transparent and understood by all interested parties, most especially generous parishioners.

One of the questions that arose during the active phase of the campaign and comes up now as well is "what project will the parish tackle first?" Once we see the amount of funds we have from the campaign, I will bring it up to the parish finance council and other consultative bodies and persons. The diocese requires any project costing \$20,000 or more to have diocesan approval and requires at least 80% of the cost be raised before beginning the project. Of all of the campaign projects, the basement project is the largest and so might take the most time. The school project will be shared jointly with Assumption Catholic Schools and must be done when school is not in session. The rectory bathroom project is smaller and with less time constraints so that might be the first. The office projects are small and we might need to shift some of those funds to some needed HVAC repair. I'll keep you updated! Don't hesitate to ask questions if you have them. ~Fr. Guanella
