FOR REPORTING INSTANCES OF CHILD ABUSE

The Diocese of La Crosse, through its policies and procedures, seeks to provide a prompt, appropriate and compassionate response to reporters of sexual abuse of a child by any diocesan agent (bishop, priest, deacon, employee, religious, vendor or volunteer). Anyone wishing to make a report of an allegation of sexual abuse should send that report to Mrs. Teresa Brown, Complaint Intake Agent, at the Diocese of La Crosse, PO Box 4004, La Crosse, WI 54602-4004. Alternatively, you can contact Mrs. Brown at 608.791.0179 or intakeagent@diolc.org. The reporting form is available through the Diocese of La Crosse Office of Safe Environment or on the diocesan website at: diolc.org/safe-environment/reporting. Individuals are also encouraged to take their reports directly to civil authorities. Copies of the diocesan policy are available through your local Parish and on the diocesan website. If you have any questions about the Diocese of La Crosse and the implementation of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People, please contact Teresa Brown, Diocese of La Crosse, at 608.791.2679 or tbrown@diolc.org.

PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Did you know that the Christmas season used to end on February 2nd?

Until 1969, the feast of the Presentation of Our Lord and Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also called Candlemas and celebrated on February 2nd, closed the Christmas season, forty days after Our Lord's birth.

The Feast of the Purification of Our Lady commemorated the purification of the Blessed Virgin, according to the Mosaic law, forty days after Christ's birth and the presentation of the Child Jesus in the temple. Mosaic law required that mothers bring to the temple a lamb for a holocaust and a young pigeon or turtle dove for sin.

During Candlemas, candles are blessed on that day and a lighted candle procession is held to commemorate Christ as the light of revelation to the Gentiles, and represents His entry into the Temple of Jerusalem.

The feast of the Presentation of Our Lord, Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary and Candlemas have a Christological significance that we should not overlook. These feasts should be looked at as a joint memorial of Son and Mother. The candles kept by the faithful in their homes should be seen as a sign of Christ "light of the world" and an expression of faith.

The Tridentine Mass still celebrates the close of the Christmas season on February 2nd. As for the reason why the church changed the liturgical calendar, still remains to be seen.
