PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Dear Friends in Christ,

Over the next few weeks and months, you'll be hearing a lot about the upcoming Church Pictorial Directory that OLQH is planning on doing. It's been 14 years since the parish has done a pictorial directory and it's time for another one. I want to this moment to explain a few of the particulars and to request some help with it.



Sometimes people ask me why a parish needs a new pictorial directory. First, it's a great way to get to know other parishioners. You'd be surprised how many parishioners, even long time ones, don't know other members of the parish. People have a tendency to go to the same Mass each week and thus only see the same people. A new directory helps people to get to know their fellow parishioners. We've had a lot of new parishioners in the parish in the last 14 years so it's past due for a new one.

Church directories are also used extensively by the parish office and clergy. It's the primary way we priests get to know who you all are and to remember your names. When a parishioner needs anointing or dies, I always look in the directory so I can "put a face with a name" if I don't already know the person. With a 14-year-old directory, that is hard. I hope everyone in the parish will take the time to be photographed so as to appear in the new directory.

The parish has partnered with *Universal Church Directories* (UCD) to produce our new pictorial directory. We will begin photography slots July 18–22. Everyone who is photographed will receive a free 8×10 photo and a free copy of the directory. I have been assured by UCD that there will be no high pressure sales to purchase more photographs but you are welcome to if you wish. If you submit a photograph instead of being photographed, there is a \$25 charge which purchases your copy of the directory.

You'll be hearing more about signing up soon, but you can already sign up for the best time slots from July 18–22. You can sign up now online or via a telephone call to the parish office. To sign up online, go to **www.ucdir.com** and then click 'Photography Scheduling Appointment.' Our church code is **wi273** and the password is **photos**. Then click on the desired photography date, then on the Reserve Time button and enter the appropriate information in all required fields and finally click on the Schedule Appointment button. You can also sign up by calling the parish office during regular business hours.

Finally, the parish does need volunteers to work sign-up tables after the Masses for in-person sign ups, as well as for working the registration tables during the photography appointments. I humbly ask for some volunteers to help with this. We need volunteers to make it happen. Please let me or the parish office know if you're willing to help. I promise it will be easy! Please let me know if you have any questions or concerns. God bless!
