

Two Views of Freedom- Dr. Edward Sri illustrates two competing views of freedom with a helpful analogy.

Free for What? - Dr. Edward Sri addresses the modern notion of freedom, a "freedom of indifference" with respect to what one chooses.

The Spiritual Exercise of St. Ignatius by Saint Ignatius of Loyola - These Spiritual Exercises were written by Ignatius of Loyola, a theologian, priest, and founder of the Society of Jesus, in the sixteenth century. They are Catholic prayers, reflections, meditations, mental exercises, and directions designed to be read and carried out over 28 to 30 days. These exercises are for Catholics and non-Catholics alike and grew out of Ignatius's desire to seek God's will and follow Christ no matter the cost. Ignatius intended that the exercises would help others to discern God's will and to set the world on fire for Christ!

Summer at Assumption Catholic Schools has been moving along guickly. A successful stay smart summer school was recently concluded. Many projects are being done and the schools are being readied for the arrival of staff on August 21 and students in grade 12 on August 28 and K-11 on August 30. The St. Lawrence ECC has been active this summer as well. We have started the process of moving parts of the central offices into the rectory at St. Vincent de Paul. We have done this to increase security at the Assumption building and also to reclaim some classrooms that are now needed for the increased number of students at the middle and high school levels.
