





PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Standing before God-What sign will you hold?

Here in Wisconsin, the State Supreme Court will be taking up a challenge of a law that has been around since Wisconsin became a State in 1848. This law, to be accurate, was enacted in 1849, making it a crime to take the life of a child in the womb of the mother. Roe v. Wade has been struck down; but not in time to save over 61 million of God's children, our fellow citizens, our future, who were not given the basic RIGHT TO LIFE. Now with a progressive State Supreme Court, a lawsuit has been filed and the fight to keep the killing of a child in the womb in Wisconsin illegal, begins, and it will be an uphill battle.

On August 15th we celebrated the Feast of the Assumption of Our Blessed Mother Mary who herself recognized the beauty and privilege of giving birth. Alongside God in his creative process, the beauty and the true miracle of birth were revealed. We celebrated our Blessed Mother's fiat, her YES to God, in allowing God's plan for redemption of us all, to go through her, through her sacred and blessed womb.

God's redemption of all mankind could have come from Jesus as a grown man, or he could have just snapped his fingers. Redemption comes through the gift of a child. From that life in the womb of Mary came our Lord into the life of the world, to lead us to the womb of the afterlife, eternal life.

We must continue praying for the protection of life. Keep praying for those whose twisted ideology states that we can kill our own, in the womb of a WOMAN, that baby's mother, right up to the time for that child of God to be born.

We will all stand before God at the end of our own lives or when Jesus comes back. We will be asked what we did for the least of us, the child in the womb. Will those who support killing a child in the womb, those who say abortion is a right, hold up that sign in Jesus' face, at that moment in their life?

We are all God's children. We will continue to pray for the protection of our own, our children, our future and for those whose hearts are hardened to the beauty and right to life. We need to hear again "what you did to the least of mine, you did to me."


