




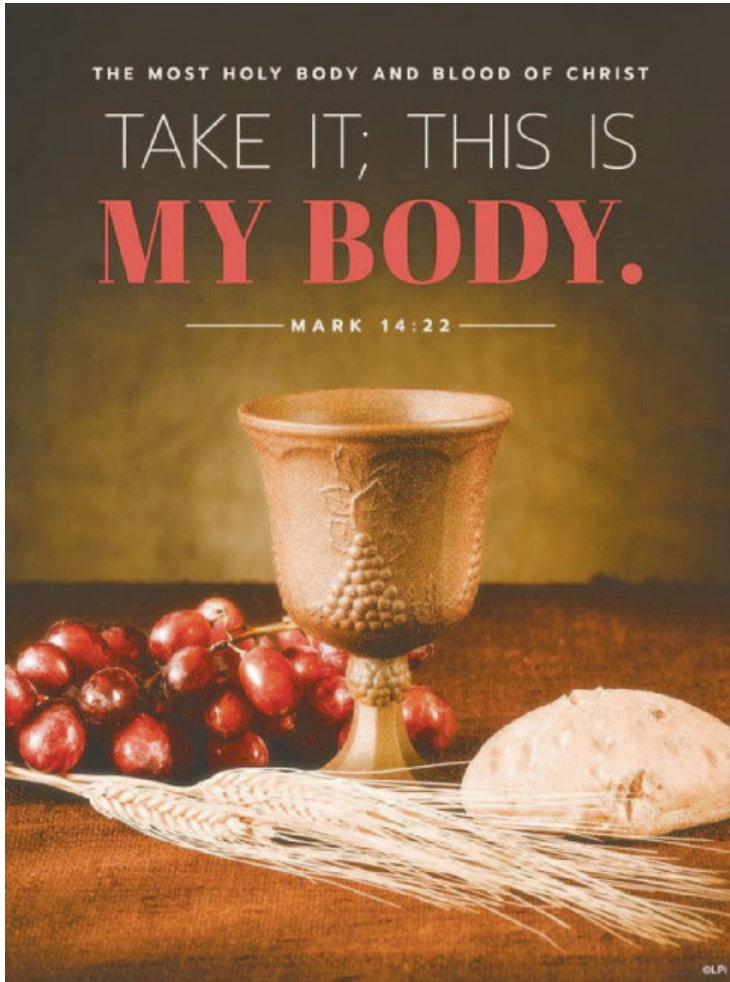

The Christian Home during June

The Christian home, known as the 'Domestic Church,' is where our children's first encounter with Jesus and the Catholic Faith takes place. Our homes should proudly reflect our Catholic identity and serve as an extension of the church. If a visitor were to step into your house, would they immediately recognize it as a Catholic home?

Whether you answered yes or no to the previous question, let's explore how to infuse more Catholicism into your home. One of the ways I personally find joy in my faith every day is by embracing the liturgical seasons. For instance, during Advent, we set up a nativity scene and light the Advent wreath. During Lent, we have a special prayer corner with a crucifix and a purple cloth. These are just a few examples of how you can make your home a reflection of your Catholic faith.

The first way my family celebrates the liturgical seasons is by observing 'Name Day.' In the Catholic tradition, 'Name Day' is a day on which a person celebrates the feast day of the saint after whom they are named. While I'm not named after a Saint, my husband and daughter are. So, each year, we honor the saint that someone is named after by having a small celebration. In the center of the table we put the picture of the saint, a prayer, and a lit candle. We start our celebration with the prayer on the Saint's Prayer card and then read a story about the Saint. After, we end our celebration with cake. This is a beautiful and reverent way to learn more about the Saint who accompanies us throughout life and to ask for their intercession.

As summer approaches, we sometimes forget about the feast days we can celebrate during the summer. The Feast and the Memorial of The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, a day dedicated to honoring the divine love of Jesus, and June 8 is the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary, a day to honor Mary's love and compassion, are two of my favorite days to celebrate during the summer. If your household doesn't already have a picture of the Sacred Heart or the Immaculate Heart of Mary, get one! Start each day by praying the Morning Consecration to Mary and the Morning offering to the Sacred Heart. Each year, you can add more to the tradition as children get older, or even if you don't have children, adding more for your spiritual growth. Spend time reading about Saints who had a deep devotion to the Sacred Heart, such as **St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, St. Gertrude the Great, and St. Teresa of Calcutta.** Sites such as Aleteia can help us understand the 12 Promises of the Sacred Heart, and Catholic Icing can help you come up with activities that you and your family can do to celebrate.

Try something new!
Don't be afraid to celebrate with others!
