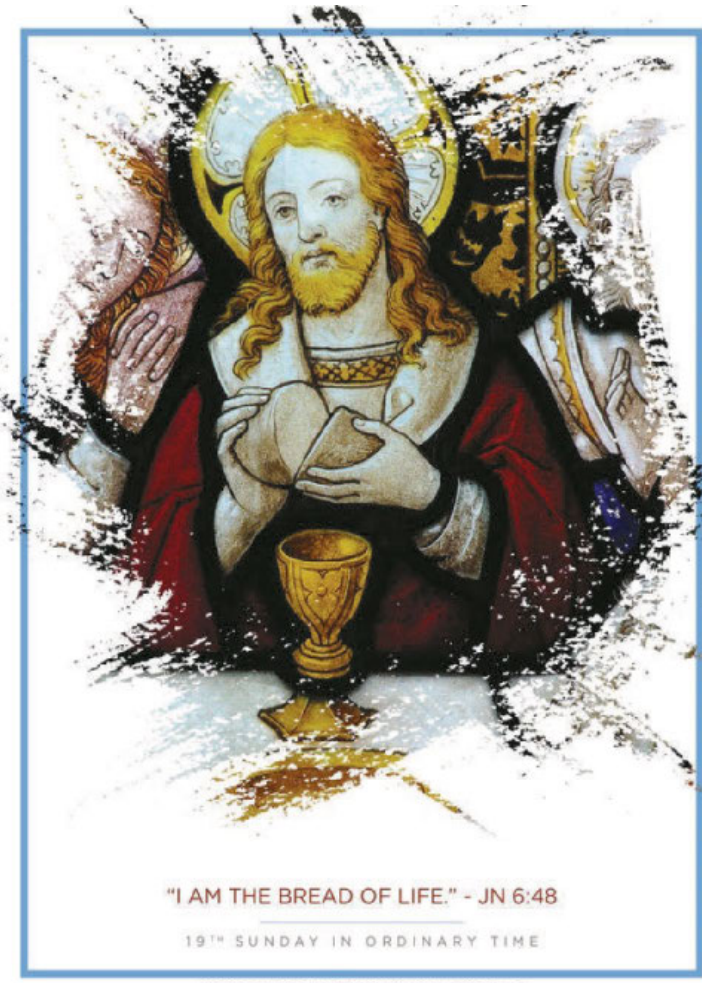
Couples requesting the celebration of Marriage should contact the parish at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

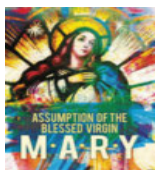



PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

I very much like J.R.R. Tolkien's *Lord of the Rings* trilogy. In fact, I read it every number of years almost as a necessity. I see in it something different perhaps than others see in it. What I do see is what I will call "faction"—it's full of fiction laden heavily with facts. It's about an epic battle. It's about the struggle between good and evil. There are arresting figures, as you know, such as Gandalf the Gray who becomes Gandalf the White. There are hobbits and men. There are elves and others. There's one particular individual who goes by the name of Strider, later to be called Aragorn. The Lord brought the *Lord of the Rings* up to me during prayer. He brought up to me the steward of Gondor, Denethor, and I thought about him and I thought what an odd thing for the Lord to bring up to me. I wondered why he brought up to me this figure—who is tragic and even a little contemptible as he devolved from his role as Steward. Jesus is the Lord we are waiting for. He is the returning King and what happens to any of us, and all of us, is that at times we forget that we are the steward and not the Lord. When Denethor forgot he was the steward, he devolved into a tyrant. He thought everything depended upon him and he felt the weight of Sauron's evil eye upon him and his realm. It must not be the same with us.

There is no room for more than one Lord in our lives. There is room for faithful stewards. There's room for men and women who are not beguiled by the power of evil but understand that their destiny, their present, their lives are caught up in the mystery of the One who has risen from the dead—caught up in the mystery of He who is Lord: who is our Lord—yours and mine—and the Lord of all creation. It is He whom the Father has intended to re-establish all creation in His Son. It is He whom you and I must turn to. We must approach Him each day, not only in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, but in those quiet moments at the end of the day, or perhaps at the beginning, when we take a moment and remember that it's not about you and it doesn't depend on you.

And whether the mountains fall and the hills turn to dust (Isaiah 54:10), it is the love of Christ that remains. Approach Him for timely aid; rest your weary head against His breast and allow Him to comfort you. He is the answer to every question which is human, as Pope John Paul II told us. He is the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6). Understand that discipleship is about love and communion. All things sacramentally in the life of virtue are ordered toward love and communion. It is the very underlying motif of our lives. It is something that we must keep always before us.
