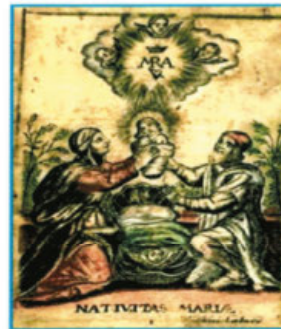

Greetings from the Social Justice Committee:
Share your harvest: There is a small cart in the gathering area where you can share your produce. If you have extra, leave it, and if you can use it, please take it. It is one small way we can take care of each other.

Coat Collection: From mid-September to mid-October, we will be collecting gently used coats for the community. This can be men's, women's or children's coats. There should be no rips or holes, and the buttons and zippers should work so the coat can be closed. Please leave them in the bins near the entrances, and we will distribute them around the community. Thank you.

PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Increasing Holiness in the home

In June, I discussed how the Christian home is also known as the 'Domestic Church.' Our homes are where our children first encounter Jesus and the Catholic Faith. This month, I want to focus on how to make our homes reflect our Catholic identity and serve as an extension of the church.

On September 5, we celebrated the feast day of St. Teresa of Calcutta. Teresa is globally recognized for her work among India's poorest of the poor. This Saint felt a strong call to serve as a missionary in India. She founded the Order called Missionaries of Charity, which is still a thriving community. Her love for the poor and marginalized is an inspiration to serve and find Christ even in those considered unlovable.

One way to celebrate this Saint is to put a picture of St. Teresa in the middle of your dining room or prayer table. At each meal, include a prayer intention for the homeless and poor. Another way to celebrate St. Teresa is to make a blessing bag for the homeless. Check with places such as Love Inc. and Focus to see what people need and put together a bag of those items.

Another wonderful feast day to celebrate is the Feast of the Archangels, also known as 'Michaelmas,' on September 29. The three archangels are chief messenger angels entrusted by God. St. Michael is a protector, St. Gabriel is a messenger of the Good News, and St. Raphael is a healer. Spend some time as a family researching these Saints. This learning journey will enlighten us about the Archangels and their roles in our faith. A great place to start learning about the Archangels is in the Bible (Daniel 10:13, Revelation 12:7, Luke 1:19, 26, John 5:4).

Since it is a feast day, get together and have a feast! The traditional Michaelmas dinner consisted of roasted goose and carrots. Since most of us don't have goose, consider roasting a chicken with carrots instead! If you don't already pray together as a family before bed, consider adding the prayer to the three Archangels. This shared prayer can strengthen your bond and unity as a family.

Heavenly King, You have given us archangels to assist us during our pilgrimage.

Saint Michael is our protector; I ask him to come to my aid, fight for all my loved ones, and protect us from danger.

Saint Gabriel is a messenger of the Good news; I ask him to help me clearly hear Your voice and to teach me the truth.

Saint Raphael is the healing angel; I ask him to take my need for healing and that of everyone I know, lift it up to Your throne of grace, and deliver us back to the gift of recovery.

Help us, O Lord, to realize more fully the reality of archangels and their desire to serve us. Holy angels, pray for us.
