## PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

Happy November! Where has the time gone? I feel like it was just Easter a few weeks ago. In this month of November, we especially remember our deceased relatives, friends, and benefactors. Here at OLQH, we have the tradition of setting up a remembrance table in church for photos of our loved ones who have gone before us. We also read the names of the dead who have died in the past year at the Masses on the first Sunday in November.



This year, we also have the Book of the Names of the Dead in the Gathering Space for you to write down the names of your deceased relatives, friends, and benefactors so that we can pray for them in the Prayer of the Faithful at Mass. Sometimes people misunderstand the Prayer of the Faithful, also called the General Intercessions or Universal Prayer. When the deacon or lay reader reads these intercessions, we are not praying to God. Rather, the deacon or reader are offering you intercessions to pray for silently. Then, after a short pause, we say "Lord, hear our prayer"—that prayer that we made in our hearts silently. You'll note that these intercessions are never addressed to God or Jesus but rather in a "For...that" style (e.g., "For the People of God, that they may be holy.") It's our job during the Prayer of the Faithful to unite our prayers to the intercession. Thus, in this month of November, when we pray for those who have died and whose names are written in the Book of the Names of the Dead, we should pray for all those in our family and circle of friends who have gone before us as well.

I also encourage everyone to visit a cemetery and offer prayers for our deceased relatives, friends, and benefactors. During the time of November 1st through November 8th, the Christian faithful who devoutly visit a cemetery and pray, if only mentally, for the dead can obtain a plenary indulgence applicable for the dead only under the usual conditions. Outside of this period, the indulgence is partial. We should also pray the prayer *Requiem aeternam* often, especially during the month of November. A partial indulgence, applicable only to the souls in purgatory, is attached to this prayer. The prayer is simply: *Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May they rest in peace. Amen.*

Furthermore, the Mass has always been the principal means by which the Church fulfills the great responsibility of charity toward the dead. I know many of you schedule Masses to be said for the repose of the souls of your deceased family members and friends. What a wonderful way to pray for the dead. In our prayers, rosaries, and remembrances, let us always pray for those who have gone before us: may they rest in peace!

Finally, on a different subject, as our country comes to Election Day this November 5th, let us pray for our country. May the will of God, through the intercession of our patroness, the Blessed Virgin Mary, the Immaculate Conception, enlighten the hearts of all voters and candidates that they may elect wise and virtuous leaders who will support the common good of all.

### Greetings from the Social Justice Committee:

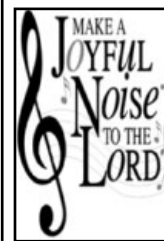
What a generous and loving parish we have. As the coat collections ended, we have donated over 150 winter coats to the community. Thank you so much.
