




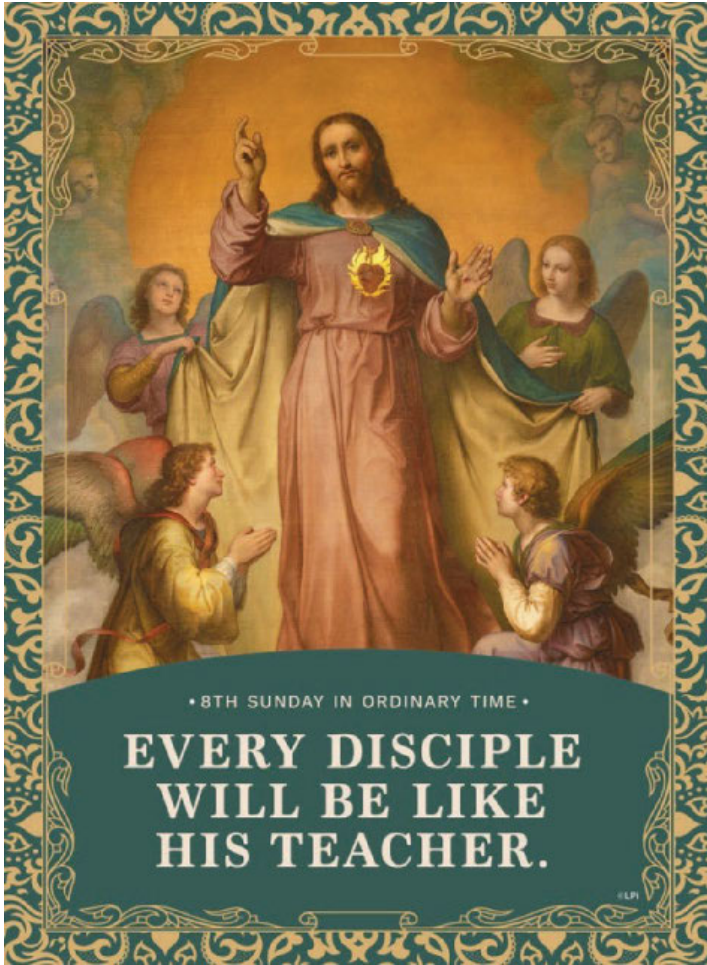

**NOTRE DAME HALL
BASEMENT RENOVATIONS**



As you read this, the church basement—*Notre Dame Hall*—is under construction. The third and final of the major *Inspired by the Spirit* campaign items has begun. Altmann Construction Company arrived to begin the renovation of the basement for use by OLQH School and the parish. While there was some hope in the early stages of the campaign that we could renovate the entire basement: the hall, maintenance shop, storage rooms, and restrooms, the plan had to be scaled back to just the main hall, both for financial reasons but also due to mechanical and structural reasons. These other areas are still perfectly usable thanks to the hard work of the OLQH Men’s Club several winters ago.

The first component of the basement renovation is to mitigate the water infiltration. After the Men’s Club’s work several winters ago, there was not too much to be done in this regard, except for replacement of the drain tile on the south side of the hall. All the water hopefully now goes to the sump pumps, which will be enclosed in closets. The hall should be dry and welcoming to all with the water infiltration mitigated. It will be better suited for school use as well as by parish groups, especially for our youth and religious education programs.

Some years ago, there were some makeshift storage rooms built for gym, Christmas, and Knights of Columbus storage. These makeshift storage rooms were demolished and new storage rooms will be built on the west side of the hall. All the old and new storage rooms will conveniently be in the same place. The parish archives room will have a new hallway and door built so that it can be locked for safekeeping. The parish is blessed to be able to have an entire room for parish archives—you’d be surprised how many items must be kept by the parish: from payroll records to used contribution envelopes, old raffle tickets, and marriage files.

The heating and cooling ductwork will be moved to bulkheads around the perimeter of the hall so that it is not hanging off the ceiling. Since OLQH School uses the hall for PE class, having a more open ceiling is beneficial. A new drop ceiling with new LED lighting will brighten up the space. The old 8-foot fluorescent light fixtures were outdated and bulbs were difficult to find. A new floor will be installed over the concrete. Since the space is used for PE class, we’ve selected a floor with a rubber base and a faux wood-grain vinyl top that will give some support for PE activities. A new coat of paint for all the walls and new doors for the hall and the boiler room will round out the project.

As always, I am very grateful for your continued financial support of the *Inspired by the Spirit* campaign. Once this third project is done, we will use the remaining funds for smaller projects around the parish such as new office carpet. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me. God bless you.
