



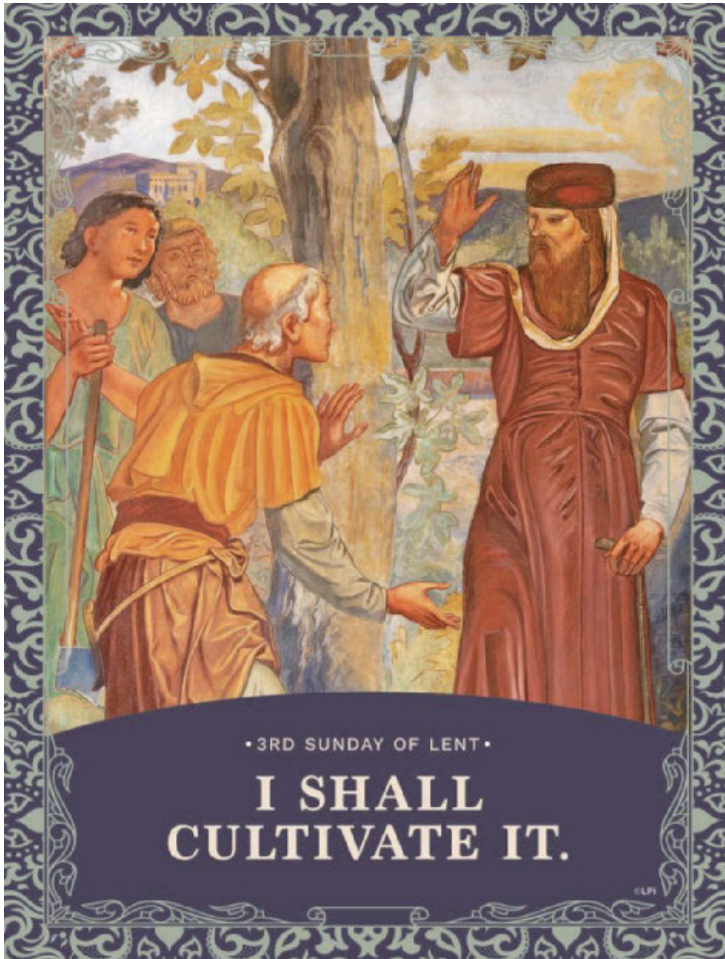

"Need help filing your income taxes? The AARP Tax Aide Program was designed to provide free assistance for low to middle-income taxpayers, with special attention to those age 60 and older. Volunteer counselors, trained in cooperation with the IRS will be available every Monday, Wednesday and select Thursdays through April 9 (8:00 am until 3 pm) at the Lowell Center.

Appointments are necessary! Call 715-422-2778 between the hours of 10:00 am and 1:00 pm, Monday through Friday, to schedule your personal tax appointment. Appointments will be determined on a first-call, first-serve basis. As a reminder, although this is a free service, donations are appreciated and greatly benefit Lowell Senior Center programming."

### Lenten Regulations:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted

## PASTORAL THOUGHTS...

### “LORD, FORGIVE US OUR TRESPASSES... (AS WE FORGIVE THOSE WHO TRESPASS AGAINST US.)”

In last Saturday's daily scripture reading according to Matthew we heard Jesus talk to his disciples about what had been said; "You shall love your neighbor and hate your enemy." Jesus flips that around and tells his disciples that one should love their enemies and at the same time pray for those who are out to persecute you. In doing this you will be children of your heavenly Father.



Jesus explains that the sun rises on both the good and the bad, and the Father sends rain that falls on both the bad and the good, that we must see his face in those we meet in our everyday lives. Love beyond those who love you.

In last Monday's daily reading according to Luke, we are told to basically imitate God, who is merciful toward each one of us. That mercy was the unconditional love of sending his only Son to die on the Cross for each one of us. The only thing that can hold us back from receiving this mercy is our own anger, our own resentment and of course those times when we just cannot find it in ourselves to forgive the one who hurt us, or ask forgiveness of one that we have hurt.

In the prayer that our Lord gave us, the Our Father, we sometimes give little thought to what I believe is the most important part of that prayer, and that is when we say, "...forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us."

We are asking our Lord for mercy, for forgiveness but only to the level that we are able to forgive.

We make many judgments every day that is part of life. Judging justly means taking the log out of our eye, before we try to take the speck out of our brother's eye.

It is hard to forgive those who cause us harm or some kind of grief in our lives, but for God all things are possible. The Cross itself allows us to see others as the Lord sees them, for from that Cross Jesus said, "Forgive them Father."

In today's cultural and political climate, it can be hard to forgive. When we look at a person whose philosophy, whose ideology is so opposed to what we believe as Christians, we can and should stand up, hold true to our moral ground; yet as we take the log out of our eyes, we must pray for those whose ideology may be in opposition to ours, and find the common ground of being able to just talk to each other, which is in short supply.

Kindness does go far in our lives; pay it forward, even to those who disagree with us. When we see others through the eyes of our Lord then that gift of mercy and love will be given back to us in good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over.

During this season of Lent let us be willing to give more than we are willing to give up. The measure we give to others will be the measure that will be given back to us.
