The Bible promises that Jesus is coming again, this time in power and glory, and this will signal the end of the world. The question of the hour is, **WILL YOU BE READY WHEN HE COMES AGAIN**? Have you ever asked yourself this? Have you ever asked yourself what it means to be ready when he comes? Does it mean you stare into space waiting for him to come?

Will you be ready when Jesus comes, or will you be surprised when you realize it is too late? Well, what are we supposed to do? Jesus tells us that he will come at an unexpected time, and when we trust this, we can alleviate all our fear because we have no idea when the world will end. We don't have to worry about whether we have one year left, one day left, or one hour left. What we do have to think about is how to be on the right side of heaven when Jesus comes, and he tells us exactly what we need to do, so we will not be shocked when he comes, but look forward and anticipate his coming even more.

Jesus gave us exactly what we need to hear in order to prepare for his second coming. It's like he already told us the answers to an exam that the world will go through when he comes, by telling us that the teacher (or the master) will be looking for this, this, and this. Jesus tells us exactly what God will be looking for when he comes, so be prepared to take some notes. This is how you will be good when Jesus comes again and be ready when he comes. He tells us we can do 3 good things:

- 1. It will be good to be found watching
- 2. It will be good to be found ready, and
- 3. It will be good to be found **doing**

When you practice these three things, you can be assured that you will be always be ready when he comes. Then, it doesn't matter when he comes, anytime is a good time for you, and what's more, when you practice these things, you will be in anticipation because there is a reward for you.

Jesus talks about 2 types of servants: one who knows his master's will but does not do it, and one who does not know the master's will, but is still wicked. When we receive the truth, when we receive revelation and insight from God, it is our responsibility to use it, or else we have wasted and blasphemed a gift from God. That is why the punishment is much worse for us who have received a trust from God, than those who have not received anything at all.

1. It will be good to be found **watching**: Like Anna, worship and pray daily

2. It will be good to be found **ready**: Battle sin in your mind, and set it on the hope of his return, and

3. It will be good to be found **doing**: Feeding and supporting God's servants.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN UPDATE

Congratulations to everyone for the generosity to our parish in the Capital Campaign. This three-year fund drive is slated to finish at the end of September. During this time, because of you, we have been able to complete many projects for our physical campus. Here are some of those projects: church roof, church gutters, EFIS siding, phone and security system, blacktop repair, water heater for the Family Center, and new lighting for the Family Center. The total received in the Capital Campaign account so far is \$120,989.75. Because there is a remainder in the account after the bills have been paid for these projects, the council has approved going forward with the remodeling of the two restrooms in the church and the office. Final bids and costs are the next phase of the remodeling. Thanks to you, the three-year Capital Campaign initiated by Monsignor Ganshert has been very successful.
