

FROM THE PASTOR:

Thanksgiving Mass...Be There!

Don't miss our Thanksgiving Day Mass at 9:00 AM! Next to First Communion, it is my favorite Mass of the year. And it comes from the recognition that we do not have to be there (it's not a Holy Day of Obligation), but we *want* to be there. And that's based on our desire to give thanks to God for all the blessings He has given us.

If we are born in the United States, well, we have a lot to be thankful for. Philosophers call it the "lottery of birth." We like to think that we are in control of our lives. That we are responsible for our successes and failures. But are we? What if we were born in sub-Sahara Africa? Would we be as successful as we are now? Would we have the size house we have now? Would we be driving the same car? Maybe, but I think likely not.

The fact is that for a whole host of reasons, we have much to be thankful owing to things outside our control. That's one of many reasons to come this Thursday (turkey preparations can wait!) and give thanks to God. Do not let a 30 second prayer of thanks at meal time be the main thanks to God on Thanksgiving Day for all He has done for us. Come to Mass, receive Jesus in the Eucharist, and in the quiet of your soul after receiving Him, thank Him for His many blessings. It's the least we owe Him on this great holiday.

New Adoration Tabernacle!

Have you seen the new tabernacle?! Spoiler alert: It's the most beautiful tabernacle you have ever seen! Many thanks are in order to our generous donor, Ann O'Malley. While she is not actually a parishioner, nor even live in Rockford, she has ties to the city of Rockford and our diocese. Her brother is Fr. Matthew Rudden, a priest of our diocese for over 50 years who has since passed away, spending his final days at nearby Presence St. Anne's Center. His last assignment was at St. Bernadette's here in Rockford, where he was the pastor there for a decade. While his legacy is in the people he served and ministered to, for those of us who do not know him, he has a lasting legacy in a most beautiful tabernacle. Please remember the family in your prayers, especially when you pay Jesus a visit at our adoration chapel. Ann made the donation in his honor as well as her other brother, John. John lived in Rockford and for a time did work for his brother at St. Bernadette's. There is a small plaque on the left side of the tabernacle that recognizes that the tabernacle was donated in their honor.

We also have another generous adorer who paid for an enhanced security system to help protect our new treasure. Praise God for such wonderful generosity!

May this wonderful addition be an opportunity for many of us to visit Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament! Maybe you were an adorer and have stopped going. Maybe you were an adorer, but COVID hit and you got out of the habit. Maybe you never went. Let this be an opportunity to give adoration a try. If an hour of mostly silence is too much for you, just come in for ten or fifteen minutes. Start small and let the Lord lead you.

Pay Him a visit and let Him speak to you. Pour out your heart to Him. Give Him your heart, and He will give you back so much more in return! Try it and you will see what I mean. So many GREAT seeds were planted in this adoration chapel that we will not know about this side of the veil. But in the next life when the veil is lifted, we will see what a treasure this chapel is to each and every one of us. Even to those who do not regularly come. It's that powerful!

As a guide to your prayer in our adoration chapel, I encourage you to keep in mind the four types of prayer, under the acronym ACTS as in Acts of the Apostles:

- A is for Adoration. Adoring God for being God. It's the least common type of prayer, but one we'd well served to practice more often. Adoration before the Blessed Sacrament is a great opportunity to do that.
- C is for Contrition. We express our sorrow for sins. We do this in confession, but we don't only have to wait to do it then. We can express our regret for sins any time.
- T is for Thanksgiving. Enough said above.
- **S** is for Supplication. This is the one we do the most. We ask God for things. It's okay to do so. In fact, He wants us to ask Him for things. So ask away!

Ultimately, if we can balance our prayer life amongst these four types of prayer, we will have made a good attempt at balanced prayer. So give it a try and check out our new adoration tabernacle!



Adoption of four siblings from foster care made family complete - Bridget Sielicki, www.liveaction.org, "November is National Adoption Month. Dawn and Mike Brostowitz never imagined that saying yes to foster care would ultimately result in doubling their family size, but that's exactly what happened when they added four siblings to their family through adoption. Planning to foster one child with hopes of adding a third child to their family, a social worker called and asked if they would

US Judge Recognizes Hippos as Persons, while Preborn Humans still have no rights - Laura Nicole, www.liveaction.org, "US courts have recognized the four hippos owned by a late Colombian cocaine kingpin, Pablo Escobar, as juridical persons while preborn human babies lag far behind in terms of rights recognized by the federal judiciary. After the death of Escobar, the animals were left undisturbed on his property. Now numbering 120 hippos, they are destroying the local ecosystem and have attacked local farmers. The Animal Legal Defense Fund (ALDF) managed to convince Judge Karen Kirkovitz to identify the animals 'juridic persons,' a distinction the judge has denied to preborn babies

in the womb. Preborn humans are not granted the same legal status as these hippos in US federal court and in many states, babies can be aborted through all nine months of gestation. In the establishment of *Roe v. Wade*, Justice Harry Blackmun recognized that *'if prenatal personhood could be established, then children in the womb would be guaranteed the right to life by the 14th Amendment of the US Constitution.'* Even the most basic protections for babies in the womb are considered highly controversial. The Born-Alive Abortion Protection Survivors Act has failed to pass the US Senate. These policymakers cannot even agree to grant legal protections to babies who *survive* abortion attempts."
