# FROM THE PASTOR:

## Evangelizing our Catholic Schools

One of my top priorities as your pastor is making sure our school kids leave here with a strong Catholic identity and desire to practice their faith. “Desire” is an important word. Kids are brought to Mass under their parents authority while they are in primary school, but after that, they begin to taste a little more freedom to choose their lifestyle when they go to high school and especially in those upper grades as they learn how to drive.

It’s no secret that many of our kids have been walking away from the faith in large numbers in this country and all of us pastors are searching for ways to keep them Catholic. I have begun with our youth minister, Eddie, and Margaret, our administrative assistant, a Holy Hour with our kids on Mondays. We have a rotation of the 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders each week that come over to the church. I expose our Lord for them for an hour and give a talk to them for 20 or so minutes. I try to address topics that speak to them and anticipate the challenges and temptations they will have to leave the faith. My first one was on the importance of the Eucharist and the second one was on science and how it is compatible with our faith. I will come back to science (if you heard my homily this weekend you got a glimpse of what I will be talking to them about.) We then play contemporary Christian music during the rest of the Holy Hour as they get a chance to reflect on what has been said. The hope is that their exposure in this way will help bring about a desire in their hearts to want to come back to church on their own.

Another aspect of our evangelization efforts in the school is to help the parents live out their faith in a deeper way. I have just hired two faith-filled school parents who will begin helping those parents in their role as the primary educator of their kids. I think to have a parent who is dealing with the same exact issues their family is dealing with, who are of the same age and so forth, will help convince some of our school parents to get more involved with their faith.

So I’m excited to announce that we have hired **Emily Howes** and **Isabelle Roiniotis** as **Assistant Directors of Evangelization**. Emily (pictured on the right) and Matthew Howes moved here about five years ago after Matthew retired from the military. A convert to the faith from being Methodist, Emily met Matthew while serving in the Marine Corps. After departing from the military, she worked in pharmaceutical sales and also taught science and math at an all-girls Catholic high school in California. Emily and Matthew have three boys—a Junior at Boylan, an 8<sup>th</sup> grader, and a 6<sup>th</sup> grader.



Isabelle (pictured on the right) and Andy moved from the Chicagoland area over 20 years ago. After they got married, they built businesses in the area and have enjoyed creating a life here. They have two boys—a 2<sup>nd</sup> grader and kindergartner. So the ages of the kids compliment each other well. As we continue to face challenges with COVID, they will use this time to plan and strategize what can be done that is safe, but is do-able. More to follow on all this in the coming months, but I am thrilled to add to energetic school moms who not only practice their faith, but have a deep love for sharing that faith with others.

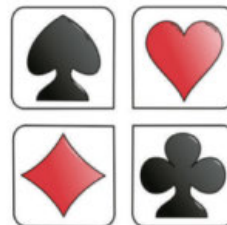
### Holy Family School's Advent Service Project to Benefit the Rockford Rescue Mission

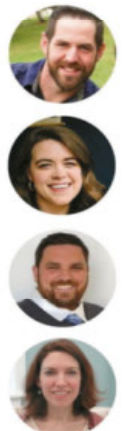

## St. Vincent de Paul Holy Family Conference Update

We just completed our fifth full year of service and are pleased to report the following fiscal 2021 activity by our volunteer parishioners:

- \*733 individuals were assisted by our home visiting team
- \*\$55,805 of financial assistance was provided
- \*\$7,129 of 'in-kind' goods and services were provided

As the volunteers bring the face of Christ and hope to our friends in need, they also provide critical information that can help those in need be referred to the appropriate local community services.

Our ability to serve was based solely on the generosity of the Holy Family community, with a significant portion coming from the parish tithe. We would also like to acknowledge Great Harvest Bread Company for their generous product contributions for the past five years.

As you may be aware, our conference SVdP has several volunteer opportunities as follows:

- o **Home Visitation Team** - along with another SVdP volunteer, visits our friends in need (FIN) at their home to provide a 'hand up' - not a 'hand out'. THIS IS THE HEART OF WHAT WE DO AND OUR BIGGEST NEED!
- o **Phone Team** - takes phone messages from the FIN's, inputs data into a data base, and shares with the Home Visitation Team.
- o **Nursing Home Team** - coordinated with the facilities, visitation to certain residents in nursing homes - emphasis on St. Anne's.
- o **Prayer Team** - monthly rosary gathering, offering prayer for our FINs, special intentions, members, and the society as a whole
- o **Fundraising Team** - conduct annual fundraising events to support SVdP efforts, i.e. Walk for the Poor, Rummage Sale and others. Works with other local SVdP conferences in the Rockford area.
- o **Technology** - much of our work is documented and computer support, training, etc. is coordinated by this committee
- o **Publicity** - promotes the activities of our organization and educates people on who we are and what we do.
