FROM THE PASTOR:

Commemorating Roe v. Wade This Weekend

As we remember the tragic anniversary that has caused the senseless killing of so many unborn children in America, I thought I would share something from a woman who regretted her decision. Patricia Raybon in her book *I Told the Mountain to Move: Learning to Pray So Things Change*, honestly shares the regret and grief she carried after aborting two children. She writes, "I had told myself that an abortion would end my problems, not complicate them by bringing an innocent life into my own upheaval. I swallowed Satan's lie, that is, then spit it out again, saying it with my own mouth."

Then she shares the following letter she wrote to her two aborted children:

Dear Babies:

This is Mama. You will know my voice, I think, even though we were together for such a short time. I did a bad thing. I didn't trust God. I didn't understand that God would have made everything okay. I was like Peter, [who] ... looked at the waves, not at Jesus. And when he looked at the waves, he started to sink—down, down, down.

That's how I felt, like I was sinking down. When the doctors said you were growing inside of me, that's how I felt, so I didn't ... know how to love you. I was afraid. Oh babies, I had made so many, many mistakes. And I was afraid. So I let fear convince me that more babies would just make things worse.

Instead, look what I did. I robbed us. First, I robbed you—taking your own lives ... I didn't think I was strong enough. So I robbed myself of all the joy you would've brought me too. Brought all of us, your sisters, your family, and for each of you, your daddy. I thought we'd have more problems. That we didn't have enough money. That we didn't have enough time. That we didn't have enough love. But I just didn't know then that God is bigger. And God would make everything all right. I didn't know ...

I know you are in heaven, waiting for us—waiting for me. I know you've been waiting, looking every day, wondering when I would get there. Oh, babies, I'm trying to get there ... to learn what God wants me to learn, so I can make it to you.

Very powerful, isn't it? A candid admission that I hope will help guide other women in their decision when they find themselves unexpectedly pregnant.

Please keep our U.S. Supreme Court in your prayers in these critical days before a decision is rendered on the court cases before them that may lead to the protection of the unborn in the womb. Pray especially for all those who identify as Catholic on the Court, that in the most consequential decision they will ever make on the Supreme Court, that they would all be one in choosing life.

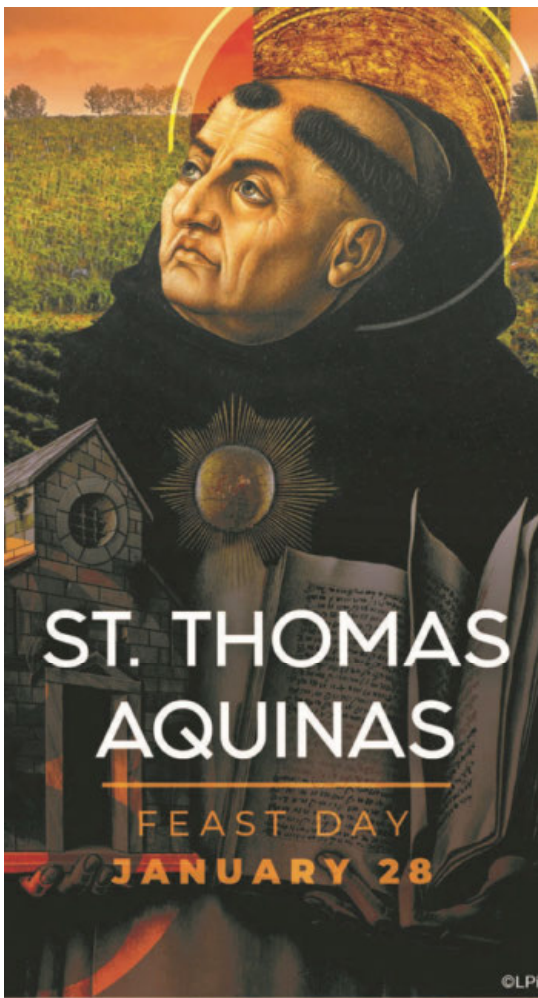

SAINT OF THE WEEK

One of the most famous members of the Dominican Order, St. Thomas Aquinas (1225 – 1274) is well-known by many for his theological work, "The Summa Theologiae." Born in Italy, his mother wanted him to become a Benedictine and had high hopes that he would eventually become abbot of Monte Cassino, where he spent much of his youth. To change his vocation, she had him kidnapped by his brothers on his way to Paris at the age of 19. He spent two years in their captivity. Despite this, nothing could shake him from his vocation to become a Dominican priest and he was eventually released. Once free, he went to Paris and then to Cologne, where he finished his studies with Albert the Great.

His greatest contribution to the Catholic Church is his writings. The unity, harmony, and continuity of faith and reason, of revealed and natural human knowledge, encompasses his writings. The Summa Theologiae, his last and, unfortunately, uncompleted work, deals with the whole of Catholic theology.

The patron saint of teachers, theologians and students, St. Thomas Aquinas died in 1274. His life and the impact he had on the whole Church, however, remains alive today.

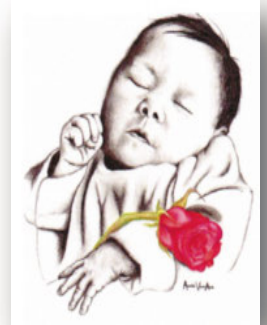

America needs no words from me to see how your decision in Roe v. Wade has deformed a great nation. The so-called right to abortion has pitted mothers against their children and women against men. It has shown violence and discord at the heart of the most intimate human relationships. It has aggravated the derogation of the father's role in an increasingly fatherless society. It has portrayed the greatest of gifts – a child – as a competitor, an intrusion, and an inconvenience. It has nominally accorded mothers unfettered dominion over the independent lives of their physically dependent sons and daughters. And in granting this unconscionable power, it has exposed many women to unjust and selfish demands from their husbands or other sexual partners. Human rights are not a privilege conferred by government. They are every human being's entitlement by virtue of his humanity. The right to life does not depend, and must not be declared to be contingent, on the pleasure of anyone else, not even a parent or a sovereign." – St. Mother Teresa

Fears that pre-born babies with autism may be screened out' - Right to Life UK, www.liveaction.org, "A study, led by University of Cambridge, the Wellcome Sanger Institute, and the University of California Los Angeles, has collected data from 10,000 participants with the stated aim to 'investigate genetic and environmental factors that contribute to the wellbeing of autistic individuals.' The National Autistic Society (NAS) has been critical of the study fearing research may lead to the development of tests to 'screen out' unborn babies on the autistic spectrum. Routine prenatal testing has been disastrous for people with Down's Syndrome who can legally be aborted at any point up to birth. People with autism are right to be wary of the same fate."
