

Transforming the World







St. Stephen

St. Stephen was the first Christian martyr. A man filled with grace and power, he worked great wonders among the people. Some Jews debated with St. Stephen but could not match his wisdom and spirit. Eventually, a charge of blasphemy was brought up against him, and he was tried and sentenced. Even in his final moments, St. Stephen displayed great forgiveness and even asked God not to hold the sins of his attackers against them.
