What is scrip??? Simply, it is gift cards!!! Parishioners consider helping our parish by using scrip! It doesn't cost you anything extra to use! Gift cards are sold at face value. We have a wide variety of retailers to choose from. If you don't see a retailer on the paper scrip order form, go to www.RaiseRight.com to see even more retailers.

Below are a few reminders when submitting a scrip order:

1) All scrip orders to be processed MUST be received **BEFORE** the start of 8:15 Mass on Sundays. You may place an online order anytime during the week. Contact Nancy Loehr at sothscrip@gmail.com for more information on how to place an online order. For paper scrip orders, you may place them in the scrip box located outside the coffee house.

2) Scrip orders may be picked up immediately after 8:15 Mass on Sundays. If it is not picked up at that time, scrip orders will be directed to the parish office. Also, if you have a back ordered item on your order, your back order will be directed to the parish office. Back orders are usually ready for pick up on Wednesdays. Parish office hours are Monday through Thursday 6:30 am to 3:00 pm. The parish office is closed on Fridays.

Plan ahead!! Scrip WILL NOT be processed on the following **Sundays:** Sunday, May 29th - Memorial Day Weekend Sunday, June 19th - Father's Day Sunday, July 3rd - Independence Weekend

Remember, we process scrip year round so keep those scrip orders coming!


