

If it is not picked up at that time, your scrip will be directed to the parish office. As summer sets in, please call ahead to make sure someone is available to distribute scrip at the parish office (477-3201). Remember, the *parish office is always closed on Fridays*. Also, if you have a back ordered items, your back ordered items will be directed to the parish office (usually Wednesdays). Online orderers, if you cannot make it to the parish office, you can always use the ship to home option under the RaiseRight app.

Our fiscal year is coming to an end on June 30th. Starting in July you will need to complete a new SOTH Scrip Agreement. Please watch for the blue form in your order envelope. Complete and return the agreement in a timely manner.




