WORSHIP & MEDITATION





Whatever the cause, to have no place to go and no place to call home takes a toll on the human spirit. For Jesus when there were hungry people, they were fed. God asks us to do the same ... feed people. There are many who are hungry physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Gifted by the Eucharistic presence of Orrist, we can bring them Christ. Who are the hungry around us and how can we feed them?


