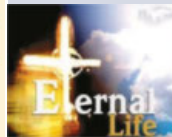


St. Vincent de Paul:

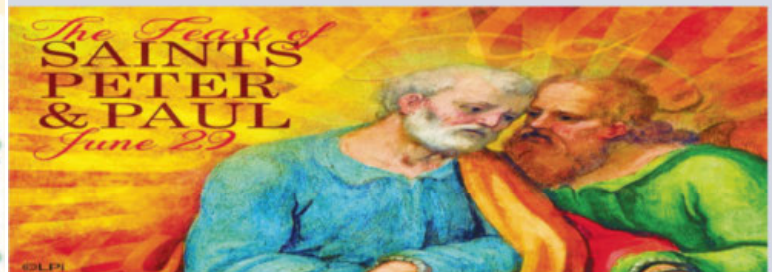

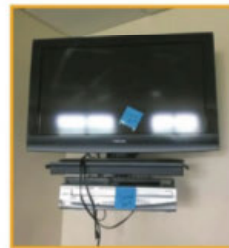

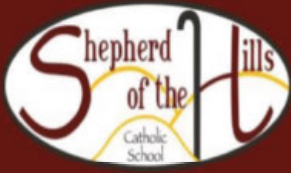

Scrip orders can be picked up immediately after 8:15 Mass on Sundays between the gift shop and parish office doors. If it is not picked up at that time, your scrip will be directed to the parish office. As summer sets in, please call ahead to make sure someone is available to distribute scrip at the parish office (477-3201). Remember, the parish office is always closed on Fridays. Also, if you have a back ordered items, your back ordered items will be directed to the parish office (usually Wednesdays). Online orderers, if you cannot make it to the parish office, you can always use the ship to home option under the RaiseRight app.

First Friday Devotion – July 1st

The First Friday devotion is associated with the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The devotion of the nine First Fridays was requested by Our Lord Himself in the revelations He made regarding His Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. It is of particular urgency that we begin or renew our devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in the spirit of reparation. The practice of the nine First Fridays is a particularly powerful way to do this, as He Himself gave us this devotion as a sure way of offering reparation to Him and consoling His Sacred Heart. Basically, the devotion consists of going to Mass and receiving Holy Communion for nine consecutive first Fridays of the month and to have the intention of making reparation to the Sacred Heart. Our Lord made twelve promises to anyone who would honor Him by this devotion. This shows His amazing mercy and love: we give Him a little thing, like the sacrifice of our time for Mass, and He gives back so much more!

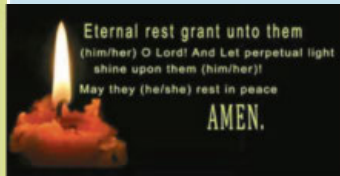
