

If you are planning to place a scrip order, please note the following:


*Orders to be processed MUST be received before the start of 8:15 Mass on Sundays.

Summer hours have begun, so please make sure you contact the parish office at 920-477-3201 to make sure someone is available for distribution before you travel there.






