





"This fall I will be starting my 5th book with Walking with Purpose. I think back to the time before the bible study and what my life was like. I was insecure and struggled with relationships. I always felt people were trying to hurt my feelings and that people didn't like me. That is how it was most of my life until I got involved in WWP. Now, I feel very much loved by my God and by the women in the community. I no longer struggle with insecurity and most of my relationships have improved because I am faith filled and that love that I feel emits to those around me.
