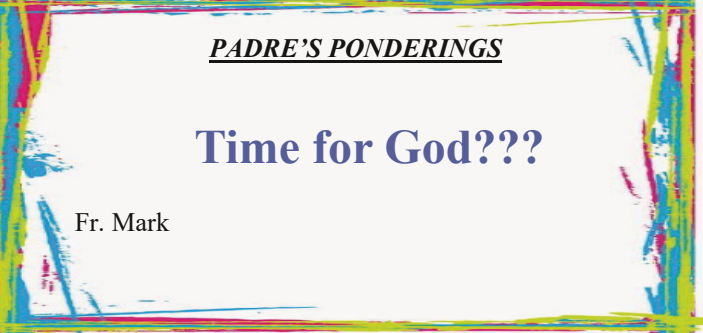
If you are planning to place a scrip order, please note the following:

**Walking with Purpose**

At the end of each year of the Bible study, Walking with Purpose takes a survey of the women in our program to see if the Spirit is moving among us. Most of the women surveyed said their relationships with family members have improved and friendships have grown/improved. Here is what one woman said.

"This fall I will be starting my 5th book with Walking with Purpose. I think back to the time before the bible study and what my life was like. I was insecure and struggled with relationships. I always felt people were trying to hurt my feelings and that people didn't like me. That is how it was most of my life until I got involved in WWP. Now, I feel very much loved by my God and by the women in the community. I no longer struggle with insecurity and most of my relationships have improved because I am faith filled and that love that I feel emits to those around me. Words can't describe how my life has changed since I joined Walking with Purpose and yours will too." Registration forms are in the back of the church or on the website.

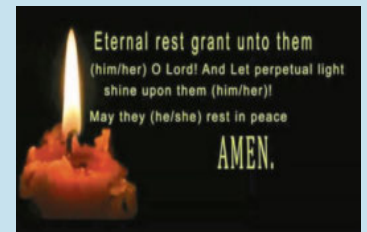
