If you are planning to place a scrip order, please note the following:

- *Orders to be processed **MUST** be received before the start of **8:15 Mass on Sundays.**
- *Online orders may be placed anytime during the week with the use of your bank account or credit cards only. This option is so convenient! If you have placed an order in the last 8 years, you already have an account in our system. Contact Nancy Loehr at sothscrip@gmail.com for more information.
- *Paper scrip orders to be processed may be placed in the scrip box located outside the coffee house.

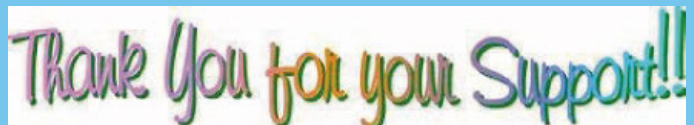
All scrip orders MUST be picked up immediately after 8:15 Mass. If you do not pick it up at that time, you will need to pick it up from the parish office.

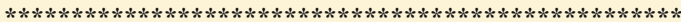


PADRE'S PONDERINGS

Comments from Fr. Mark

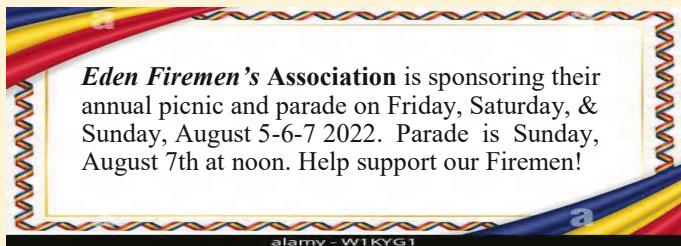

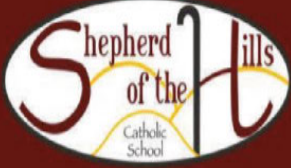
A Prayer for Help from our Blessed Mother

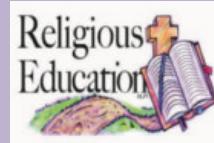

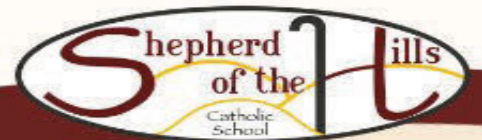
