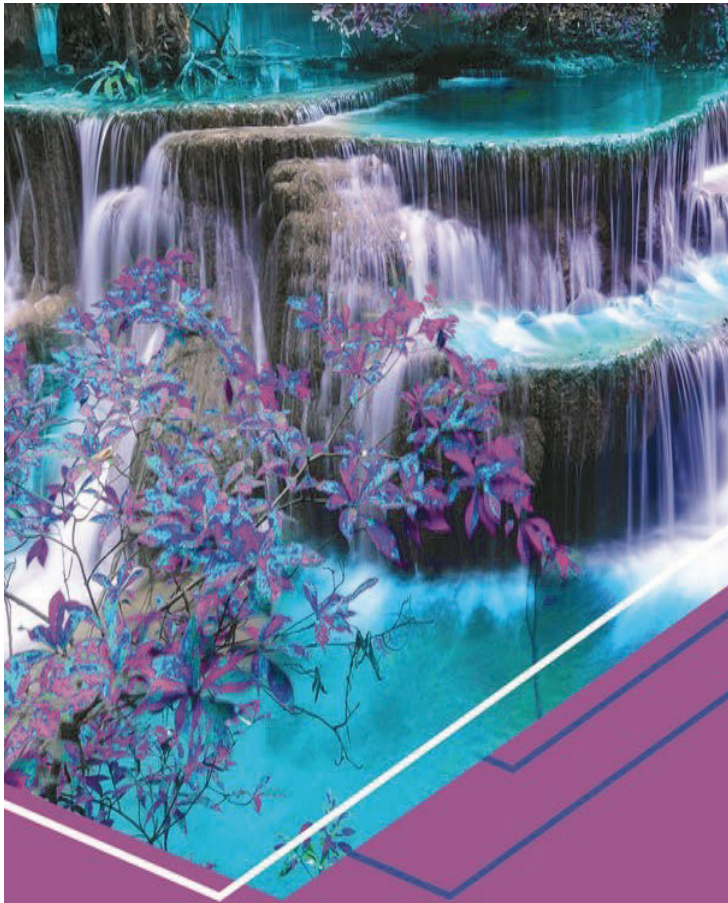

\*Online orders may be placed anytime during the week with the use of your bank account or credit cards only. This option is so convenient! \*Paper scrip orders to be processed may be placed in the scrip box located outside the coffee house.

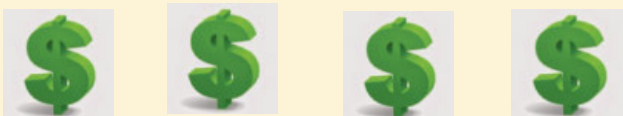

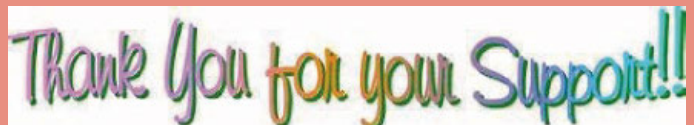

We are offering 2 options.

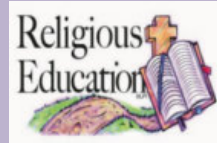
**Luncheon:** Doors open at 11:00am. Lunch will be served at 11:30 am. The program begins at 12:00 pm and will conclude by 1 pm.

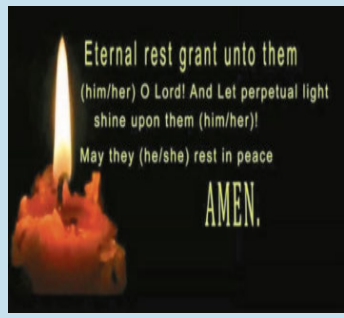
**Our Mother of Perpetual Help Devotion - Every Friday**
