

Scrip facts:



Scrip is processed on Sundays except holidays.

Orders can be placed online or a paper order form may be completed.

All orders to be processed **must** be received before the start of 8:15 Mass.

Orders may be picked up *immediately* after 8:15 Mass on Sundays. If not picked up at that time, they will be directed to the parish office. The parish office is on summer hours, so please call ahead (920-477-3201) before you go to pick up your scrip order.


