Wisdom 1:13-15 2:23-24 * Psalm 30:2, 4, 5-6, 11, 12, 13 * 2 Corinthians 8:7, 9, 13-15 * Mark 5:21-43

Fear and Faith. Two stories today told by Saint Mark. Both start in fear. Fear by the woman touching Jesus' cloak and making him unclean. Fear by Jairus over his dying daughter, who regrettably dies before Jesus gets to her. Jesus words to both: faith saves; have faith.
