Meet Megan Stram, our new Pastoral Associate!

Blessed Sacrament has been a home to me for the past 5 years, so the opportunity to work here is such a blessing and I could not be more excited to serve the parish as the Pastoral Associate. This role will allow me to get to know even more people in the parish while continuing to be a part of the committees, events, and groups that I have been involved with already. As the Pastoral Associate, I will be working with a lot of different aspects of the parish, such as RCIA, pastoral care for the elderly, adult education and faith formation, and assisting any ministry in serving or meeting the particular goal or purpose of the ministry. This is such a dynamic role and I'm excited to assist parishioners and staff in encountering the Lord through each person's unique gifts and talents. Please feel free to reach out to me if you know of an area of the parish that needs attention, to talk about what you're doing and how I can support you to keep things going, or you need somebody to talk to.

Here's a little bit about me: I grew up in Prairie du Chien, WI, just a couple blocks from the Mississippi River. In 2009, I moved to Madison to start school at UW, eventually majoring in Rehabilitation Psychology. It was during my time there that I re-discovered the Church and my faith at St. Paul's University Catholic Center. My senior year, I lived in an outreach house on Mifflin St. that was organized by the Evangelical Catholic. This experience led me to apply to be a missionary with the EC in a program they had, the Campus Ministry Training program. I absolutely loved the experience of working in ministry and learned a lot about the Catholic faith, evangelization, community, and myself along the way. After a year of ministry, I went back into my field of study for the next 6 years, working in residential services for people with developmental disabilities, most recently with Catholic Charities. During this time, I moved into the Dudgeon- Monroe neighborhood and started attending Blessed Sacrament. After being involved in various ministries, I finally (officially) joined the parish about 4 years ago. Being a member of the parish has led me to serve and be served in so many ways. I am closer to the Lord and a better version of myself because of my experiences here. I accepted this job exactly three weeks after accepting the proposal of my wonderful fiancé, Nathan, and two weeks before moving out of my home of 5 years. Throughout all of this transition, the Lord has given me so much joy and peace, both which I plan on carrying through in my ministry to the parish. When I'm not at Blessed Sacrament, Costco, or wedding planning, I enjoy pretty much anything outdoors (hunting, fishing, kayaking, hiking, and hammocking are my top 5), jigsaw puzzles, board games, and meeting up with friends and family for meals, coffee, tea, a movie, above mentioned activities, etc.




