Is RCIA for YOU?

RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. This is the process through which adults and children over age 7 ioin or complete their initiation into the Catholic Church. This includes Confirmation for adults. For baptisms, the Church requires that at least one godparent to be an active confirmed Catholic. RCIA may be for you, if you find yourself in one of these situations ..

- You are baptized Catholic but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation and/or Eucharist (1st communion).
- You might be asked to be a Baptismal or Confirmation sponsor, but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- You are baptized in another Christian Tradition but feel called to explore Catholicism
- You are not baptized but wish to be, or you have an unbaptized child who is at least age 9, and would like them to be baptized.
