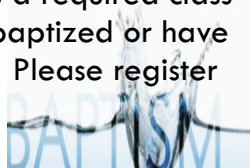

Is RCIA for YOU?

RCIA stands for the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults. This is the process through which adults and children over age 7 join or complete their initiation into the Catholic Church. This includes Confirmation for adults. For baptisms, the Church requires that at least one godparent to be an active confirmed Catholic. RCIA may be for you, if you find yourself in one of these situations ..

- ◆ You are baptized Catholic but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation and/or Eucharist (1st communion).
- ◆ You might be asked to be a Baptismal or Confirmation sponsor, but have not received the Sacrament of Confirmation.
- ◆ You are baptized in another Christian Tradition but feel called to explore Catholicism
- ◆ You are not baptized but wish to be, or you have an unbaptized child who is at least age 9, and would like them to be baptized.

Ski Club 2021-2022



The Ski (and Snowboard) Club is open to all students who are in 4th-12th grades, however, younger students may ski provided they are accompanied by an adult. Lessons are required for all beginners. A student card, which includes 1 free lesson, must be purchased for \$25.00 per student. This card allows evaluation for the advanced hills' lifts and also offers a discounted rate on Sunday-Friday (after 3:00).

We ski at Alpine Valley Ski Resort on Friday nights. Parents are responsible for transporting their children to and from Alpine Valley. The student rate is \$25.00 per lift ticket and \$25.00 per rental; helmet rentals are \$10. Parents/guests are welcome to ski with us on our group outings at the same rate offered to the ski club members. We meet at Alpine Valley Ski Resort in East Troy at approximately 4:00 p.m., and ski until 9:00. We meet in the main lodge in the cafeteria area by the fireplace. (If this changes due to Covid, you will be notified.)

Our outing ends at 9:00 pm. All students must check in by 9:00 pm in order to verify that everyone has a parent/ guardian present. Families are welcome to stay until 10:00 pm when the hill closes, however, parents/guardians are responsible for their children after 9:00 pm.

- ✓ Subject to change due to inclement weather/conditions
- ✓ Come to as many or as few as you want- no commitment!

It is helpful to have advance notice for anyone who will ski each week.
