Liturgical Ministers

As we learned last weekend, our Mass times will be changing to 4:00 Saturday and 10:15 Sunday, effective the first weekend of July. This change will understandably have an effect on your service to HMC going forward, especially concerning the following:

- **Preferred Mass Times:** for the next month, please tell me your preferred Mass time when offering your availability.
- **Retirement from Service:** if you find that one of our neighboring parishes has a Mass time that better suits your family, please let us know and we'll remove your address from our ministry email list. EMHCs, please remember that your diocesan training is transferrable, though other churches will most likely want an orientation to their spaces.
- **Lectors and Prayer Leaders:** Starting in July, we will assign two ministers per Mass to divide the roles. At this time, sufficient numbers of lectors, across all Masses, have returned to the ministry to allow us to provide these opportunities.

Altar Servers will return to service on Saturdays in July, provided they have enough supervised service at 10:15 to be fully independent. If you have questions regarding your children(s) readiness, talk to Michele Ring after Mass or send Larry an email.

National Eucharistic Revival: A Roadmap



At the urging of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, all Catholics of our nation are part of an unfolding 3-year plan—to help ensure that the Eucharist is properly understood and valued as the “source and summit” of our Christian lives. (Go to the national site at www.eucharisticrevival.org to learn more.) Here’s a snapshot of what this plan looks like, with parishioners becoming actively involved starting next month:

PHASE 1: YEAR OF DIOCESAN REVIVAL June 19, 2022 – June 11, 2023

This first year of the Revival invites diocesan staff, bishops, and priests to respond to the Lord’s personal invitation and equips them to share this love with the faithful through eucharistic congresses and events.

PHASE 2: YEAR OF PARISH REVIVAL June 11, 2023 – July 17, 2024

The second phase will foster Eucharistic devotion at the parish level, strengthening our liturgical life through faithful celebration of the Mass, Eucharistic Adoration, missions, resources, preaching, and organic movements of the Holy Spirit.

- TBD: HMC sessions to increase understanding of the Eucharist
- Other parish-based Holy Hours with the bishop, happening around the diocese

PHASE 3: NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC CONGRESS July 17 – 21, 2024 in Indianapolis, Indiana
