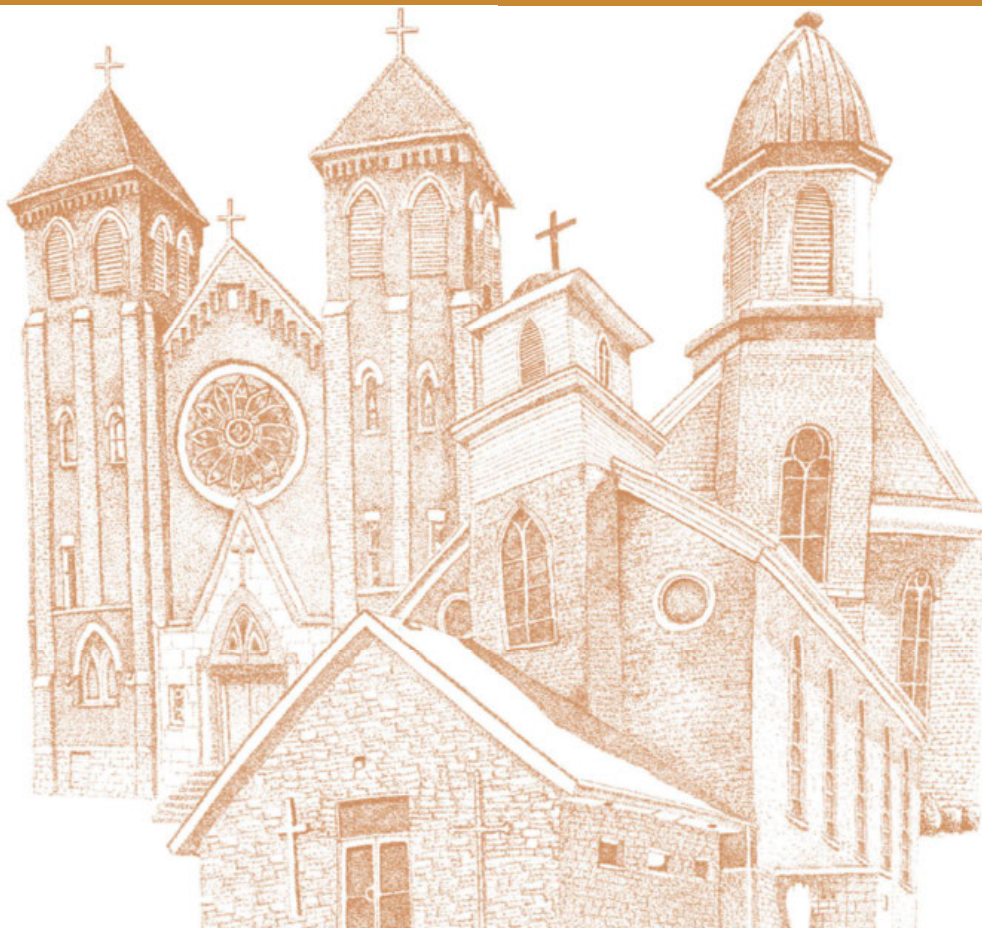

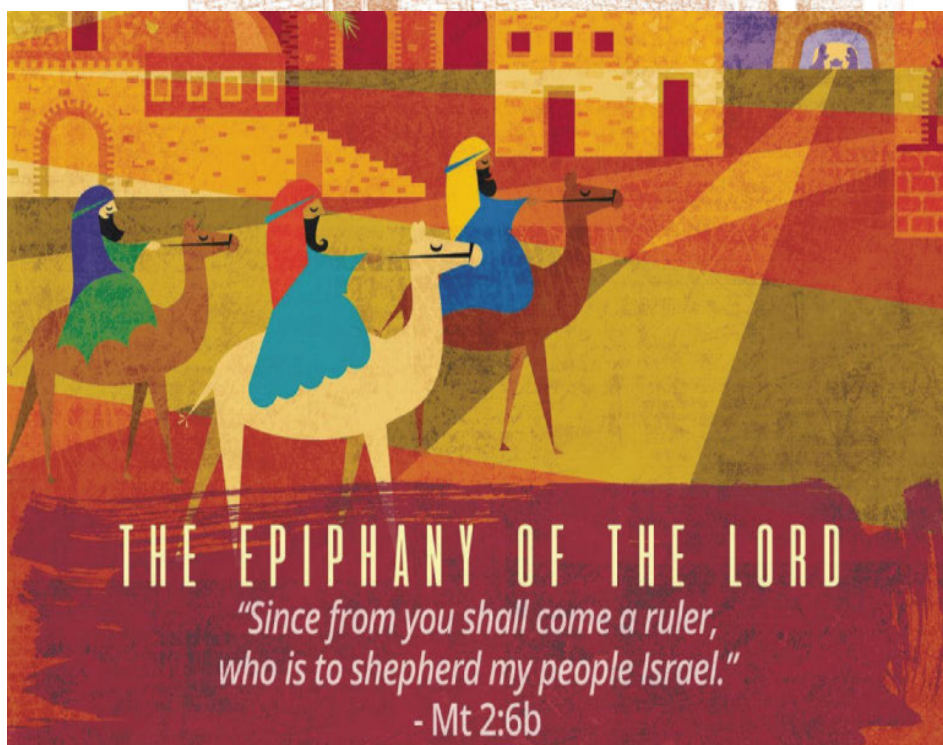

Pizza Sale Results

When we kicked off our Church/School/Family Care Pizza fundraiser in October, we reached for the stars and set goals of \$7,000 for the church and \$16,000 for the school and family care. How did we do? The church's profit was \$717.30 and the school/family care profit was \$13,309.72.

Campaign for St. Kilian, St. Martin, and St. Matthew

This is the 4th update in 2021 about our fundraising campaign for special needs of the Chapels and the Church.

St. Kilian Chapel replaced the filtration system and main pump for the boiler in 2019 in preparation for the new boiler. The new boiler was installed and cost \$20,350. As of December 15th, you have donated \$14,060.94.

St. Martin Chapel replaced one side of the church roof in 2015 for \$14,000. It is time to replace the other side of the roof and we expect it to cost at least \$15,000. As of December 15th, you have donated \$17,629 to pay for it.

The lawn tractor at St. Matthew Church is used year-round to cut grass and plow snow. It's time to replace it at a minimum cost of \$5,000. As of December 15th, you have donated \$6,019.
