



Campaign for St. Kilian, St. Martin, and St. Matthew

This is the 4th update on our fundraising campaign for special needs of the Chapels and the Church.

St. Kilian Chapel replaced the filtration system and main pump for the boiler in 2019 and the new boiler was installed in 2021 at a cost of \$20,350. As of December 31st, you have donated \$17,115.94 towards its purchase.

St. Martin Chapel replaced one side of the church roof in 2015 for \$14,000. We expect the cost of the new roof for the other side of the church to be at least \$15,000. As of December 31st, you have donated \$18,409 to pay for it.

The lawn tractor at St. Matthew Church is used year-round to cut grass and plow snow. The recent estimate to replace it is approximately \$13,000. As of December 31st, you have donated \$9,659.01.
