### Christian Marriage

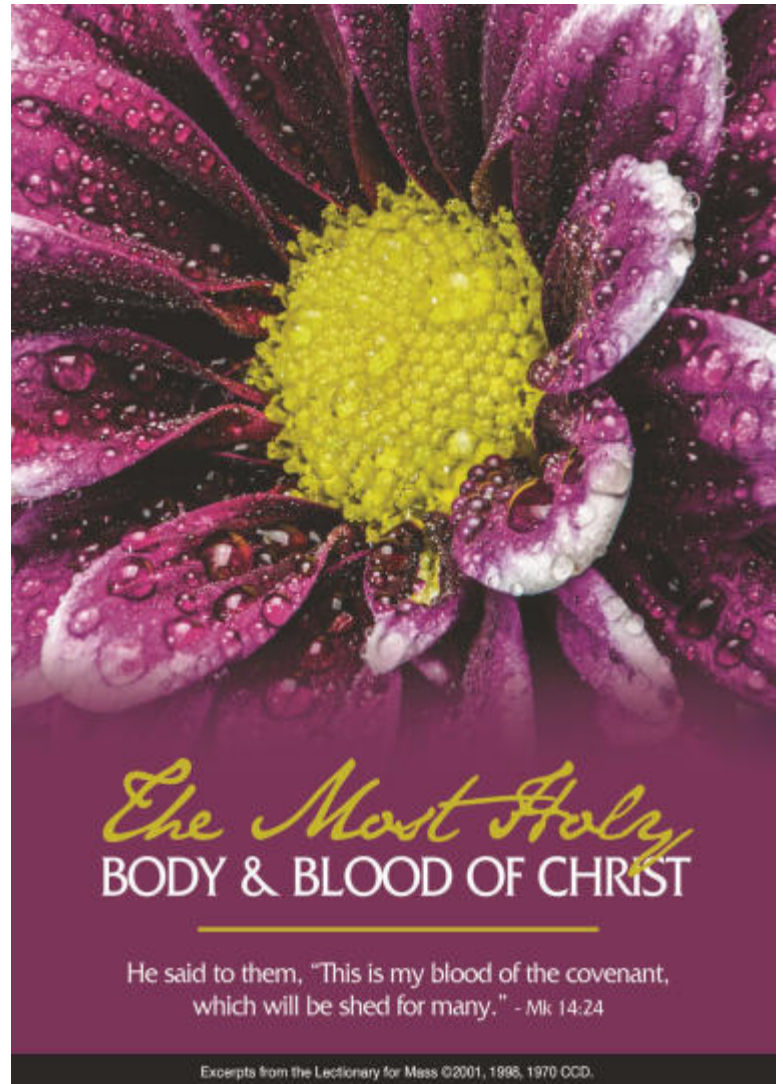
Couples should contact the Pastor at least six months in

## From the Shared Pastor's Desk (Father Rick):

**Catholic Comeback** – Began with Pentecost 2020 and took significant steps forward as of Pentecost 2021; we're able to welcome unrestricted full attendance without social distance or face coverings while providing designated seating for those who would enjoy/need this consideration; choirs will again be allowed (most of ours likely will return in fall as they customarily take summer off); we'll begin to resume Mass periodically in assisted living/nursing homes when their parameters for resident safety allow; we will again be able to have funeral visitations at church; luncheons after a funeral are being considered if they involve individually wrapped/served food (no self-service buffets); other parish meals/fundraisers are again possible as dine-in, pick-up or drive-thru service; child/youth ministry activity will be able to expand in-person classes and gatherings; we have Holy Water and the Sign of Peace back! All this involves ongoing diligence with regard to extra cleaning and safety protocols to assure the comfort and well-being of all; we will also do everything possible to maintain respect for the feelings and needs of each. Thank you for your patience with so many things we couldn't do or have had to do differently for so very long; we look forward to seeing your smiling face as we continue to return to whatever the new normal may involve!

**For the Time Being** – Reception of Holy Communion is maintained under one species and recommended to be in the hand only; If reception on the tongue is allowed (this may vary from priest to priest and parish to parish; we allow for this only AFTER all those who receive in the hand have done so first; we may not allow alternate distribution between hand and tongue). Also, for the Sign of Peace, please be respectful of personal preferences of those near you; if not known to you, a smile and a bow, saying "Peace be with you," is courteous and cheerful; an extended hand or a hug is welcome among those in the same household, family or with established relationships.

**Holy Communion to the Homebound** – Individuals may again take Communion home to spouses or family members, provided they use an appropriate pyx. These may be purchased through one of our priests for \$5 each (accompanied by a handy home prayer guide); we will no longer have pyx "on loan" for occasional use; you'll need to own your own.

**The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)** – This Sunday's feast day honors the Real Presence of Christ in the Most Holy Eucharist. Consider this saying: *"If anything could shake my faith in the Eucharist it would not be the doubt as to how the bread could become flesh ... but if I ask myself how he could love us so much as to make himself our food, I can only answer that this is a mystery of faith."* (St. Alphonsus Liguori) During this coming week we'll also observe the feasts of the Sacred Heart of Jesus (Friday) and Immaculate Heart of Mary (Saturday). The Sacred Heart statues in each of our churches physically depict what St. Margaret Mary Alacoque said she saw between 1673-1675 in a series of visions - Jesus' exposed heart and redemptive wounds displaying His passionate mercy and compassion for the human race. Two decades prior to this mystical experience by St. Margaret Mary, the priest who became an ardent promoter of her devotion to the Sacred Heart, St. John Eudes, was celebrating a liturgical feast in honor of the Immaculate Heart of Mary as he went about preaching parish missions, encouraging conversions and total change of life by those who had grown lax or neglectful in the practice of the faith. That these feasts were eventually joined is no accident as devotion to Mary always leads to a greater faith and a deeper relationship with her Son and Our Lord; to Jesus through Mary! Sacred Heart devotions are part of regular First Friday 8AM Masses @ Resurrection and Mass here Saturday mornings may often enough have special Marian emphasis; praying the rosary before each Mass is also spiritually beneficial; think about coming early enough to at least slip in a decade or two!

**Graduations** – Of all sorts have been observed, will or are being presented at this time of year. Children, youth/young adults are being promoted from anything from 5K, elementary, middle and high school, from college to a meaningful job or advanced degrees; some adults have managed to complete interrupted educations while still working each day. These steps forward, great or small, represent significant progress in becoming more of who we can and are called to be, God's servants, gifted with knowledge that hopefully we will use generously to help fashion a more loving, sharing and trusting world.
