Christian Marriage

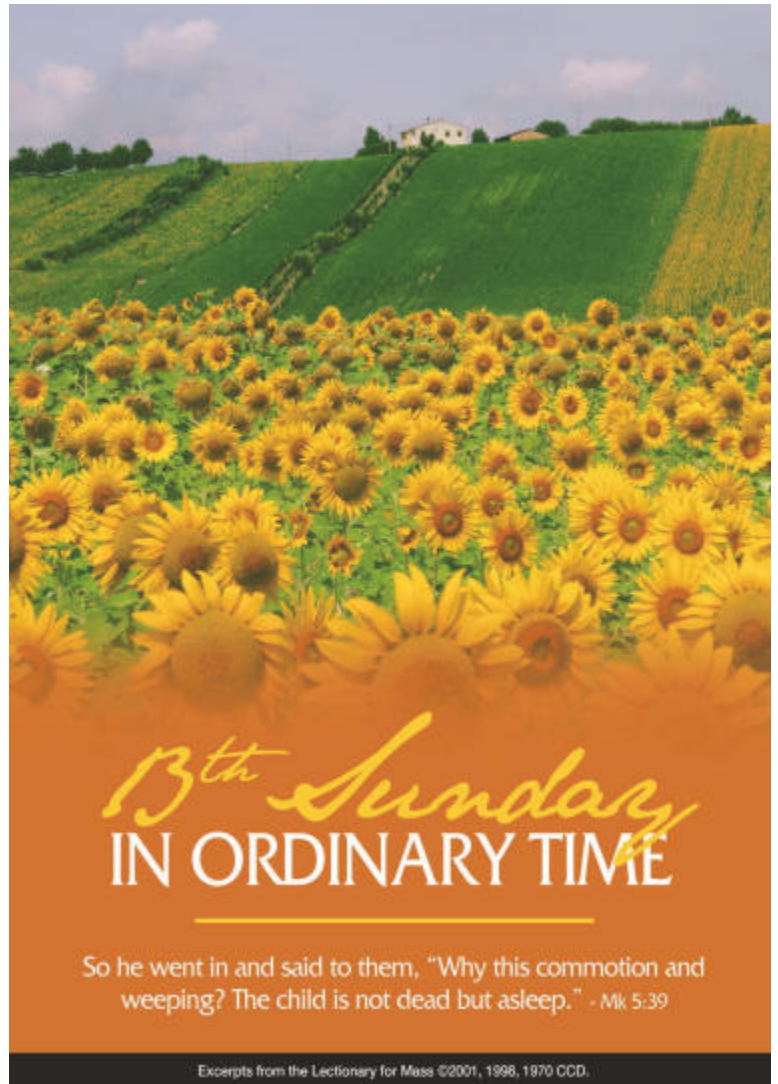
Couples should contact the Pastor at least six months in

From the Shared Associate Pastor's Desk (Fr. Jonathon):

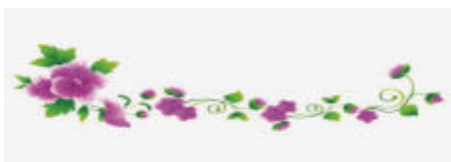
VIRTUES, Part 2: In the bulletin two weeks ago, I started a series of articles about the virtues. I gave the definition from the *Catechism*: "A virtue is an habitual and firm disposition to do the good." They go on to quote St Gregory of Nyssa: "The goal of the virtuous life is to become like God." (CCC 1803) All of the virtues help us to become more fully human. They help us to lead a truly good life. There are four human virtues: prudence, justice, fortitude, and temperance. There are three theological virtues: faith, hope, and charity, which are all gifts given directly by God.

Today, let us focus on the virtue of **prudence**. Saint Thomas Aquinas calls prudence, "right reason in action." Or another way to understand it: Prudence is the ability to look at things in the world and see them as they really are, and respond and make decisions according to the truth of things. A very basic example: a prudent person sees a bowl of wax fruit. He or she looks at and examines the bowl of fake, inedible fruit. Seeing things as they really are, he or she does not eat the fruit. Right reason in looking at these food decorations prevents the prudent person from making a miserable first bite.

How can we can develop this habit of seeing the world around us truthfully and acting in response to it? Asking good questions and studying the created world and ideas helps us to understand what they really are. Soliciting advice from people who are older or wiser helps us to see situations with family, friends or coworkers with a cool, level-headedness – rather than rashly responding in anger or frustration. While this takes effort on our part, it will later help us to make good responses to life's problems and to do so more promptly.

Saints Peter & Paul: This week, on June 29, we celebrate the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul. This is a great feast in the Church's calendar because it celebrates two of the preeminent apostles who Jesus appointed to make his name known through the world. The preface of the Mass today says that Peter and Paul, "each in a different way gathered together the one family of Christ." This celebration should remind us that we are united to Catholics and other Christians throughout the world through the preaching, example, and martyrdom of these great apostles.

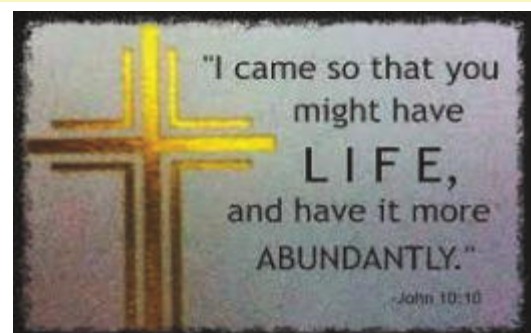
