Christian Marriage

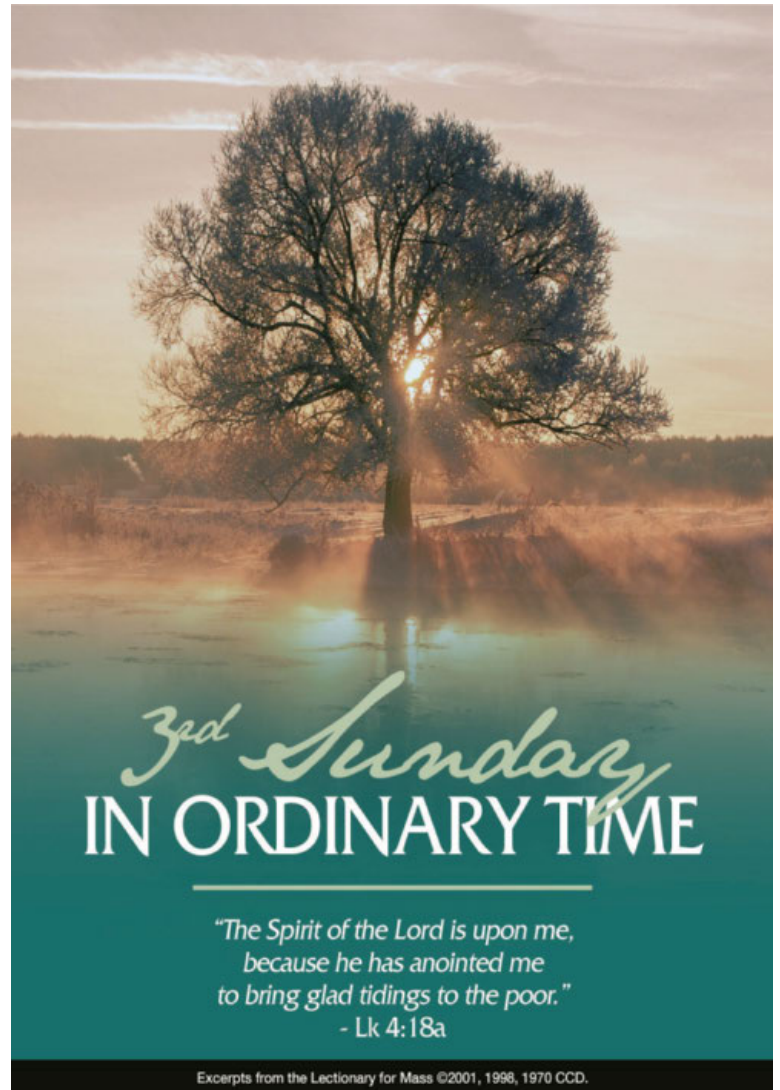
Couples should contact the Pastor at least six months in

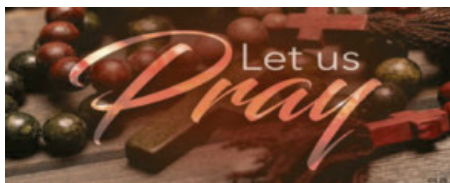

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

People can easily lose a sense of the sacred and transcendent. When we lose a sense of God's special presence, we need to be brought back. Ezra brought people back to the word of God and they realized what they were missing. Jesus proclaims God's word in the synagogue with true conviction and tells those gathered that he is the fulfillment of all that Isaiah taught. Even though people get lost, distracted, discouraged, and often journey down the wrong path, God's timeless law remains. When we allow ourselves to truly hear God's word and act on it, that living word slowly, over time, changes us. It has the power to soften and mold us, creating within us a joyful spirit. We realize the truth in what God speaks and become open to God's love. Gradually and gently God leads us back where we belong. We discover again the sacred character of life and the wonder of God's power. It is no wonder that Luke addresses his remarks to Theophilus. It is a name that means "beloved of God," a name that can be used by anyone who desires friendship with God.

Sunday, January 23, 2022 *3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time*

From the Shared Associate Pastor's Desk (Fr. Jonathon):

Today we celebrate **Sunday of the Word of God**. Begun by Pope Francis' instruction, this day is now always celebrated on the Third Sunday of Ordinary Time. The Holy Father wants all Catholics to spend more time reading and praying with the Bible, with the inspired word of God. As we celebrate this day, it's good to make sure that, as a family, we all have a Bible in a prominent place in our homes, that we open and read it, that we are familiarly with the gift that God has given us in his words.

In doing so, Pope Francis echoes his predecessor, Pope Benedict XVI, in encouraging us to regularly practice what is called *lectio divina* - an ancient and relevant **way to pray with Sacred Scriptures**. There are four basic 'steps' involved in this way to pray. You could use these steps to pray with any passage of scripture. A good starting point could be the Gospel from Sunday Mass (this Sunday's is: Luke 1:14; 4:14-21).

First: *reading (lectio)*. Read the passage out loud. Pay attention to words or phrases that stand out to you. Re-read the passage. Pay attention to what God draws your attention to.

Second: *meditation (meditatio)*. Why does the word or phrase stand out to you? What memories, hopes or dreams does it connect to? Or, even nightmares, fears or concerns?

Third: *prayer (oratio)*. Speaking to God: God, why do you want me to think and pray about this word or passage? Jesus, what are you trying to say to me through the Scriptures today? Holy Spirit, open my heart to receive your Word!

Fourth: *contemplation (contemplatio)*. Think of *contemplation* as resting with God. Listening to Him, loving Him, adoring Him. Think of how you can grow in love for Him through this time of prayer. What is He calling you to do, to change in your life, or see differently?

This way of praying with Sacred Scripture is a powerful way to grow in our daily habit of prayer. It helps us to hear and respond to God's Word. It even helps us in our spiritual battle against sin and evil in our lives. At a conference I attended earlier this month, one of the speakers, a priest who is an exorcist, recommended *lectio divina* as a powerful means of thwarting the Evil One (in addition to recourse to the Sacraments and a life of virtue).

On this Sunday of the Word of God, let us resolve to turn to the Scriptures in our daily lives as a source of comfort, protection, and life with Him who speaks to us!
