Fr. Stoffel's Stuff:

Just A Thought – Why do we wash bath towels? Aren't we clean when we use them?

Human Dignity – “The truth is that each human being, regardless of their vulnerabilities, receives his or her dignity from the sole fact of being willed and loved by God. Thus, every effort should be made to encourage the *inclusion* and active participation of those who are affected by frailty or disability in the life of society and of the Church.” *Dignitas Infinita*: Vatican, #53.

Saints Peter and Paul – Whose feast day we observed this Saturday, are involved in the history of our cluster parishes in several ways; the former Ss. Peter & Paul in Nenno, founded in 1848, merged to help form Resurrection, Allenton, in 1997; the parish in Slinger chose St. Peter as patron saint in 1856 when then Schleisingerville was known, as Slinger still is, as the village of seven hills, like the city of Rome where St. Peter gave the ultimate witness to his faith for the sake of the Catholic Church still headquartered there on Vatican Hill.

Eucharistic Pilgrimage – My appreciation and congratulations to Fr. Russ and the team he got together to facilitate our participation in the Eucharistic Pilgrimage that passed through our part of Washington County last Wednesday. As there were many pieces to coordinate and juggle on many levels – local, regional and national – this required not only much creativity but also lots of patience on the part of those representing our three parishes; they said they felt like they were flying a plane while it was still being built! So much came together so very well & I'm so pleased with the deeper sense and spirit of collaboration this effort evidenced in our cluster community. This is most fitting as, after all, the Eucharist, the Real Presence of Christ among us, with us and within us is Who brings us together not only around His altar but also as His disciples on mission, empowered take Him into the world for its salvation, and ours, too! On a personal note, it was an honor for me to bring the Eucharistic Pilgrimage Procession up the last 0.3 miles from the Slinger Community Park to St. Peter's for the time of Adoration that was afforded before the Eucharist moved on, ever edging toward Indianapolis and July's Eucharistic Congress there that several members of our parishes will attend, representing us, carrying us in their hearts/souls. Continue to pray for the success of our Eucharistic Revival!

2024-2025 Annual Budget Mailing – If you have not already, you will soon be receiving in your snail-mail, email or by social media your copy of our annual budget for the coming fiscal year as well as a letter summarizing the state of the parish as shared at last week's annual meeting for those who were unable to attend. Watch for yours!

Increased Mass Stipends – As of Monday, July 01, 2024, the offering for Mass Stipends has been increased from \$10 to **\$20** per Mass as decreed by the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin; this is not retroactive & will be in place for those arranging Mass Intentions in every parish across the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and throughout parishes in each diocese in the State of Wisconsin. The offering for Mass Intentions was not adjusted in at least the last **45** years and was due for reconsideration. If someone cannot afford the newly stated amount, a free-will offering can be accepted for the Mass Intention(s) requested.

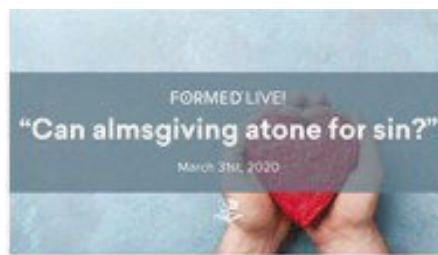
Who can celebrate the Mass?
