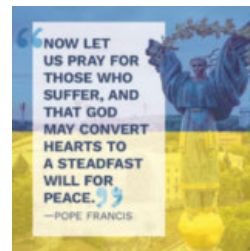

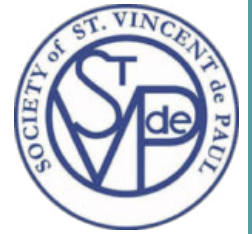

SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

We are onboarding new members and I have been asked a number of times recently what motivated me to join. On this Feast of Divine Mercy, I recall a priest once opening his homily with “We do not *deserve* mercy; that would imply that we *earned* it. Mercy is a *gift* from God.” I think about all the times I have been forgiven and all the times I have been spared from, or helped through, difficulties rooted in our broken world. I did not earn any of it. In receiving these gifts, I can only be thankful and joyful; and so I am moved to share it through the SVdP ministry.

This week we met with a woman who receives about \$1000 per month in social security and food stamps and is caring for 3 of her grandsons between the ages of 7 and 10. She requested help with rent and utilities. She was recently approved for section 8 rental assistance and is looking for a new place to live. The house she currently rents would not pass inspection. She didn’t owe a lot, but must be current on her rent and utilities when she signs the section 8 contract on a new place.

She explained that she did not pay March rent because the house had changed owners and she didn’t know who to pay it to. Unfortunately, she didn’t set the payment aside either, but spent it. She also requested help with a balance due on her water bill. I told her I had called the water company and learned that she had a zero balance because a state program for low income residents had covered it. We saw the relief on her face and she whispered “Praise God!”.

She then shared with us challenges she had overcome in her past. She said even though she is on disability now, she does what she can to help at her church. She was confident God had sent us to help her, just as God is working through her to provide a better life for her grandsons. Her faith was inspiring and humbling. For those of us with so many resources, we have to stop and think about Divine Mercy in our lives. This woman however is mindful of it daily as she struggles to meet the most basic needs for her family.

We helped her with rent and paid a small balance due to Ameren. With section 8 we think she will be in a more sustainable situation. Thank you for your generous donations and please pray for us and our friends in need.

All women of the School and Parish are welcomed to join us at our next SVdP Women's Guild Meeting and Ladies Social on Thursday, May 12th at 6pm in the Parish Hall. We will start with a quick 30 minute Guild meeting, all are welcome! Immediately following at 6:30pm we will start our social. There will be cheese, wine, and fellowship. Please join us!

Financial Assistance Available
 Tuition assistance scholarship grants from the endowment fund established as a result of the Diocese of Peoria ROOTED IN FAITH Campaign and named in honor of Archbishop Spalding, the first Bishop of Peoria, will be available for the 2022-2023 school year for students enrolled in or intending to enroll in grades Kindergarten through 12 in any Catholic school located in the Diocese of Peoria whose families are active members of a Catholic parish in the diocese. All grants will be based on financial need objectively assessed.

Information about the grants and application materials may be obtained from any Catholic elementary or secondary school in the Diocese of Peoria or on the Diocesan website www.cdop.org under **Catholic Education** and then under **Financial Assistance**. Consult the detailed protocols and procedures and checklist for all requirements necessary to be eligible for an award.

Parents must apply online at: www.online.factsmgmt.com/aid
 Families of students currently receiving grants are reminded that all grants are for one year only, and anyone seeking to renew a grant for the 2022-2023 school year must reapply. Deadline date for the completed application is **April 29, 2022**. Notification of grant awards will be made by the end of June 2022.

Another funding opportunity is also available due to the Invest in Kids Act legislation in Illinois. Students may be eligible for up to 100% of tuition and fees under a new program for tax credit scholarships (TCS). Details on how to apply and who qualifies are available on the Empower Illinois website at www.empowerillinois.org
 Students who receive a TCS are ineligible to receive a Spalding award.

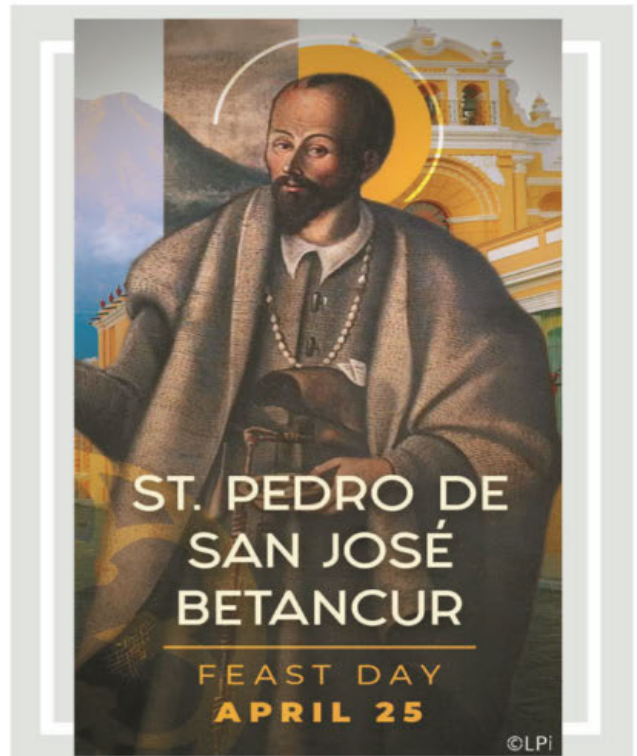

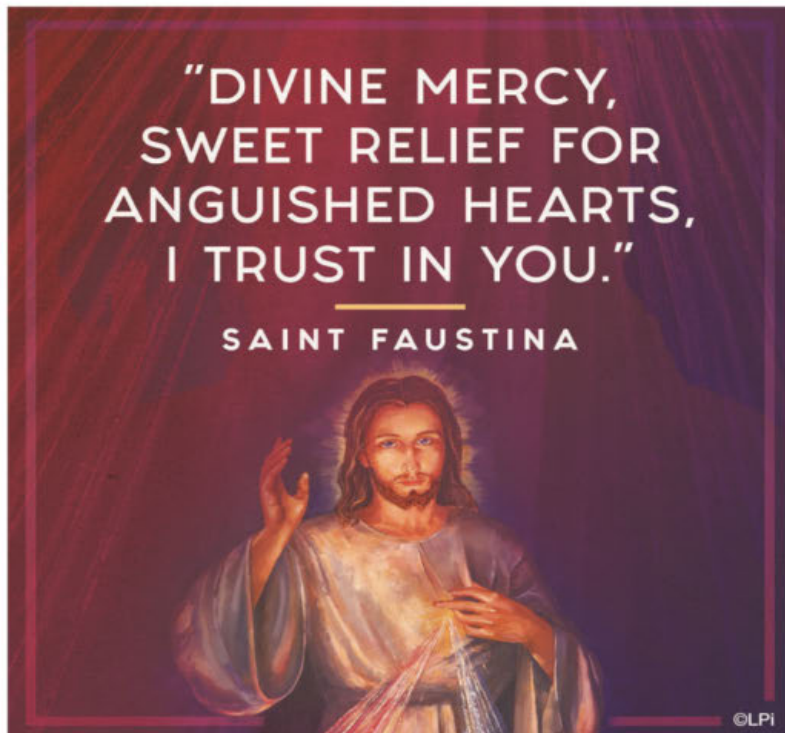


Saint of the Week

Central America's first saint, St. Pedro de San José Betancur (1626-1667) was born a poor shepherd in the Canary Islands. His family lands were seized because of debt, and he worked as an indentured servant until his early adult life when Pedro left his home to travel to Guatemala. His money for the journey ran out long before he arrived. He was destitute when he did arrive and was forced to join the bread line the Franciscan Friars had for the poor.

In 1655, he joined the Third Order of St Francis. Pedro began to serve the poor, the enslaved, immigrants, abandoned children, anyone that needed him. In 1658 he was given a hut which he made into a hospital for the poor. This small start grew into a shelter for the homeless, a school for the poor, an inn for priests, and several small chapels in poor areas. He was supported by many patrons and was joined in his work by both men and women, who became the Bethlehemite Brothers and the Bethlehemite Sisters.

Pedro prayed for the souls of those in purgatory, walked through the streets of rich neighborhoods ringing a bell and calling the wealthy to repent, and ministered to prisoners. Most accounts credit him with beginning the tradition of *posadas*, a procession in which people representing Mary and Joseph ask for lodging from their neighbors. This tradition continues today in Mexico and Central America. Because of his work with the poor and marginalized Pedro is often referred to as the "Saint Frances of the Americas". St. Pedro was canonized on July 30, 2002, in Guatemala City, Guatemala by Pope John Paul II.
