



SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL

We recently received a call from a 56 year old woman who works as a certified nursing assistant at a small assisted living facility. It was the first time she had called us. She only had about half of her monthly rent. She said her other bills were higher than expected and her tax return money was exhausted, which was how she had been managing.

As we often do, we asked her about her earnings and expenses and determined she had less than \$50 discretionary income each month. We asked her for ideas on how she thought she could save and she immediately pointed out that she needed to stop smoking. We shared with her a list of food pantries. She said she didn't eat much and food stamps covered it, but we pointed out that she could get non-food items to free up cash for her utilities. We also shared information about a new program for low income households to receive \$30 per month discount on their internet bills.

Her greatest expense after her rent was a near \$400 car payment. She said she still had 18 months left on the loan. She said she had been trying to pay a little extra each month because the interest was so high. Many of the people we help have car loans with interest rates around 20%. Repossessions are common. Hopefully this woman will be able to complete her payments.

Lastly, we asked her about looking for a better paying job. We pointed out that her wage was on the low side of what CNAs are earning now. She explained that she had worked for a nursing home, but the lifting that was required was hurting her back. Her current job mostly requires her to give the residents their medication and visit briefly with each one. She has been there about 6 months. She said she has always worked in healthcare and truly enjoys it. She was aware that there are higher wages, particularly at the hospitals, but she was concerned about the trauma she would be exposed to. She said she would think about it.

Before we left, we prayed with her. Please pray for her and so many like her. She is among the working poor who have done the same work since being young, but as they age, have to be more selective of the jobs they take and the pay is less. They face difficult choices and a short illness or unexpected expense can lead to losing the few luxuries they have like a personal vehicle.

Thank you for your ongoing generosity. At this time the pantry is in need of laundry detergent and cleaning supplies.



Saint of the Week

Born to nobility, St. Norbert of Xanten, was ordained as a subdeacon and served in the court of Henry V, Emperor of Germany, however, at court it was easy to be distracted by wealth, power and luxury and he lived a worldly and corrupt life there. By the grace of God while traveling in a storm he was nearly struck by lightning and almost killed. This experience changed St. Norbert and he became penitent, left his court post, and after a period of discernment in a monastery, felt called to be a priest.

Norbert became an itinerant preacher, preaching against worldly attitudes but at the Pope's request finally settled in northern France and founded the Norbertine order established according to the rule of St. Augustine. The order grew rapidly and soon founded women's branch. Norbert traveled and preached across Germany where he also founded a lay branch of the Norbertines. In Belgium he preached against heresies which denied the Blessed Sacrament.

Eventually he was made Archbishop of Magdeburg, Germany, and later he traveled to Rome in support of Pope Innocent II, against the antipope. Afterward he returned to Germany to court of Emperor Lothar as advisor, at end of life, in failing health, St. Norbert was carried back to Magdeburg where he died.
