

Society of St. Vincent de Paul

Happy New Year! The responsorial psalm today is from Psalm 72 and says, in part, "For he shall rescue the poor when they cry out . . . He shall have pity for the lowly and the poor . . ." As members of the St. Vincent de Paul Society, with God's grace, we try also to rescue the poor when they cry out, calling our Helpline. We've had some time off while our Helpline was closed for the Christmas season, but certainly there will be several calls coming in during the coming weeks. Christmas is an especially difficult time for the hourly workers in area schools who can't work when schools are closed. This would include bus drivers and monitors, cafeteria workers, and teacher's aides to mention a few. Their income isn't usually high enough to be able to save for times such as this, and many of them are single parents so they are the only "breadwinner" in the family. Of course they wanted their children to have something under the tree, so not only is income less than normal, but expenses around Christmas always seem to be higher. We try to help them understand that it is more important to pay the rent, the Ameren and the water BEFORE spending money on gifts, but by the time we're visiting with them, it's too late to change that. As we talk about their monthly expenses and how they budget their money, this is the time of year when we can begin to talk about how they will spend their tax refunds. We can encourage starting a savings account to plan for future challenges, or paying a month's rent in advance but pretending like they didn't so that they are always a month ahead. It's a great opportunity to "rescue the poor when they cry out" by helping in some way with their current need, but also by educating them on how to avoid having the same thing happen next year.

Your financial donations allow us to provide the needed financial help when appropriate. Your donations of requested items for the pantry allow us to take boxes of healthy food and needed non-food items to those we visit. We especially need all types of soaps right now. With the colder weather, many would be pleased to receive chapstick and lotions also. Finally, your prayer support is essential! We feel safe knowing that we are surrounded by prayers of our parishioners. Also, those we visit need your prayers. You know some of their stories if you read this blurb in the bulletin regularly, but we visit many families each week, and each family has their own unique circumstances that are causing distress. 
