



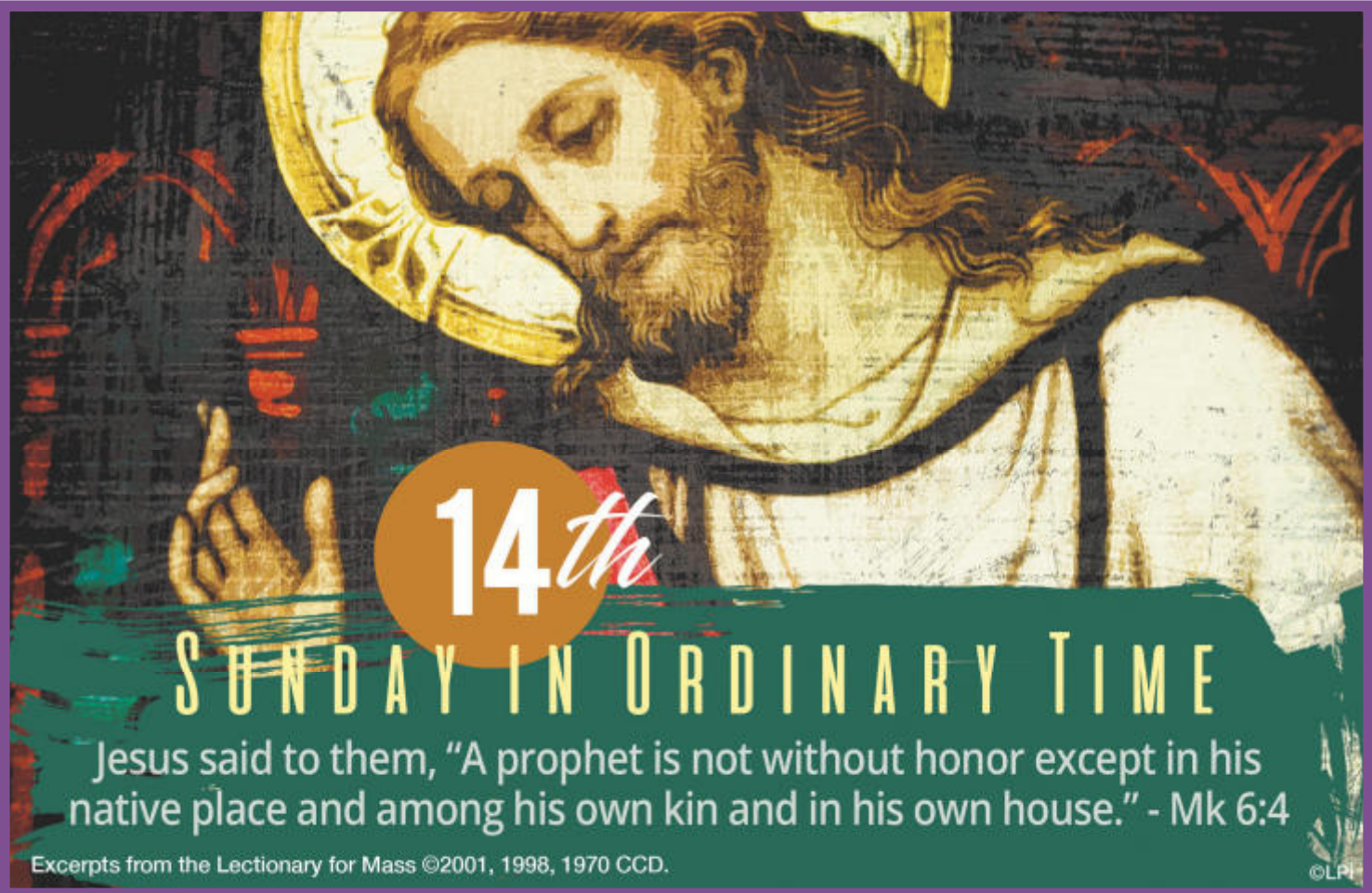

FOR STS. PETER AND PAUL & MOUNT OLIVET CEMETERIES

The sexton is essential in caring for our cemeteries! The sexton, under the direction of the administrator, provides necessary maintenance and planning not provided by the contracted lawn mowing service. The sexton also works closely with the administrator and parish bookkeeper in the regular business of the cemetery. With the pastor, the sexton helps the parishioners get involved in taking care of our cemeteries.

The sexton should want to:

- Serve God and the Church
- Work Outside
- Be a Helpful and Welcoming Face of the Parish to Families

Our parish cemeteries have served Catholics in the Spring Valley area since 1892. The sexton can help this essential ministry flourish in a new generation! You will have a generous amount of support from the administrator and parish staff. If you've never worked at a cemetery, don't worry, but experience with outdoor maintenance is necessary. Outdoor maintenance such as trimming, spraying, and planting grass seed are important tasks of the trade! This is a part-time position with up to 30 hours of work possible each month, March through November. The pay is \$15 per hour. If you possess the characteristics and desire for this position, please ask for more information by contacting the parish office at 815-663-3731.

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,

Greetings in the Lord! As you can see we have a number of activities to help us keep engaged in our journey of faith in the Lord. For young people (boys and girls ages 5-17) we have a camp called Totus Tuus taking place the week of July 25 in both LaSalle and Princeton. The Diocese is offering Emmaus Days sessions for boys from seventh grade to sophomore year still to come the week of July 18. This is a valuable opportunity to recharge before the school year. We have our Thursday evening bible studies which you can still come to, even if you were not present for the first session. These are all times where we can have both recreation and re-creation. You'll be glad you attended.

As you can see we are also looking for a sexton to care for two of our cemeteries. The hours are not extensive, but there is certainly need for care which is more than a few volunteers or I can handle. If you are interested or know someone who is please let me know.

As we are tweaking our restrictions on COVID-19 mitigation I want to thank you for your assistance. As those of you who have been at Mass physically have noticed, we have sections where masks and social distancing are optional, and these will vary as we have different numbers more comfortable with one section or the other. We have discontinued spraying each pew with disinfectant, but it is available in the hall for your use. If you or a family member sneezes you may want to spray down your pew for the sake of the folks who will sit there later. Finally, thanks to our ushers / greeters for their generous help at the doors for the last year. May God bless you richly.

I will be away June 28-July 2, and July 10-16. We will not have weekday Masses those days, but Sunday Masses will be at their normal times, and the church doors will be open at their usual hours throughout the day.
