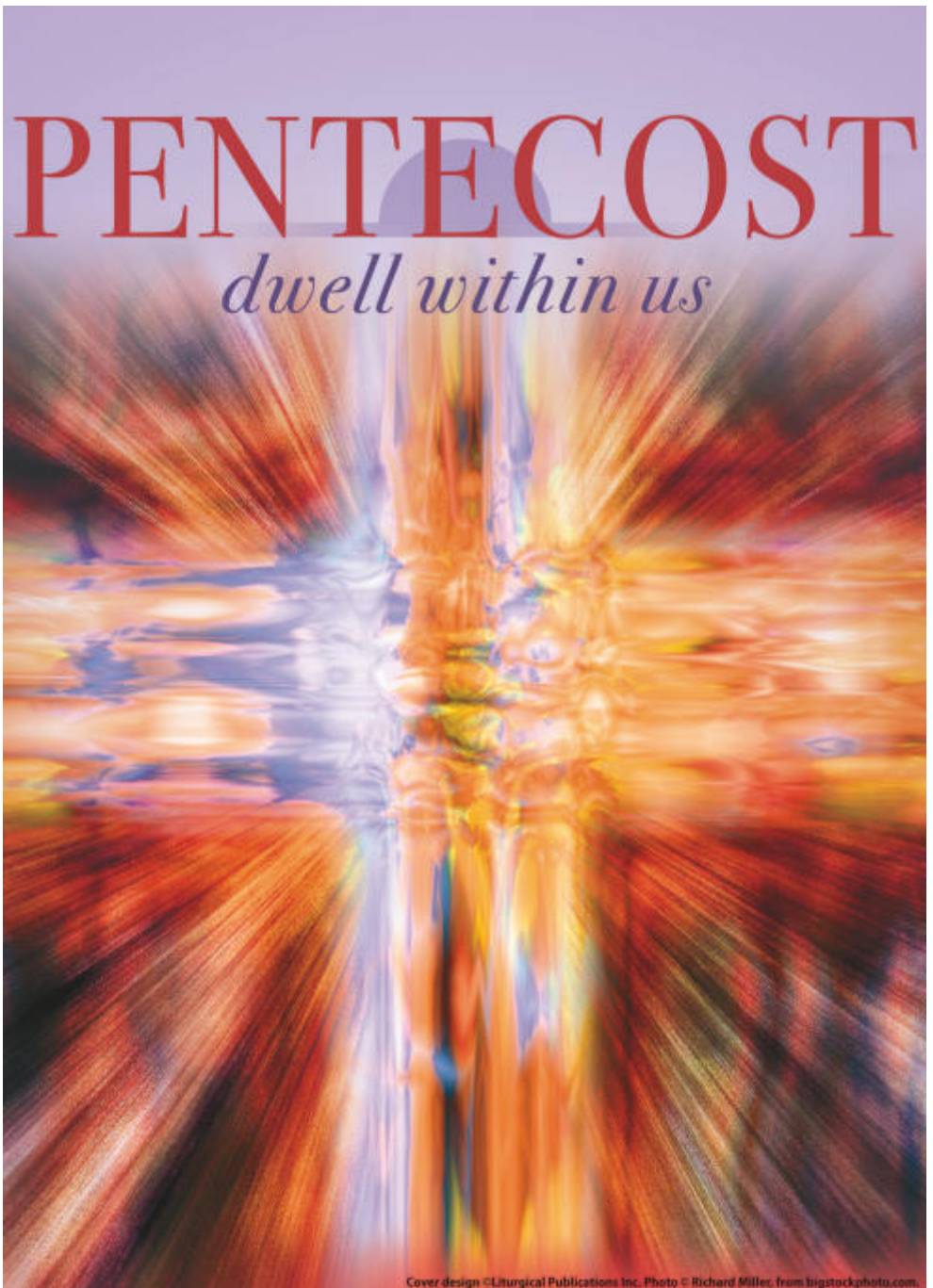

## Pentecost Sunday

"God is always more." Have you ever heard that? If we truly believe that He is infinite, then this statement is worth exploring. Today, we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit in power upon the early Church. But Pentecost wasn't the first time the disciples received the Holy Spirit. The Gospel actually occurs

chronologically before Pentecost. Soon after the Resurrection, Jesus already "came and stood in their [the disciples'] midst... he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'"

God is always more. Sometimes we might think the grace of God as one and done. God might break through in people's lives, but it's a one-time event on a retreat or preceding a dramatic conversion of life. But there's always more to come. Even today's Gospel isn't the first time the breath of God stirred. In Genesis, it's God's breath that stirs life into Adam in the garden. Jesus breathes on the Apostles, giving them the Holy Spirit in the quiet and silence. Later, that breath will stir into a "driving wind", and the Spirit will descend with flame...not unlike Moses on Mount Sinai.

God is always more. He has spoken throughout salvation history, and continues to speak into our lives through His Church and through the Holy Spirit alive in our hearts. This Pentecost Sunday, let us come before Him with expectant hearts! Like the disciples in the Gospel and first reading, let us await what "more" God will do.



## A Blessed Pentecost to all of you!

When the disciples received the Holy Spirit, they were able to proclaim God's Word in a way that everyone could understand, no matter their culture, their country of origin, or the language they spoke. When early Christians received the Holy Spirit, they were able to serve the Body of Christ, the Church, with unique spiritual gifts. Since we have received the Holy Spirit and continue to be filled with the Holy Spirit, let us ponder how we can use our gifts for others.

COME HOLY SPIRIT AS WE LISTEN TO YOUR HOLY WORD! .....

God comes to us and dwells in us through the Holy Spirit in different ways. The coming of the Holy Spirit is presented dramatically in Acts, as a strong driving wind. In John's Gospel, the Spirit is given subtly, as a gentle breeze. The gifts of the Holy Spirit are even more varied, as St. Paul preaches. No matter how they are received or revealed, they transform our lives. Let us welcome the Holy Spirit into our lives and into our world.

QUESTION OF THE WEEK .....

"Lord, send out your Spirit and renew the face of the earth," we sang in the Responsorial Psalm. Having received the Holy Spirit, how can I assist in renewing the face of the earth?
