



#### FROM THE DESK OF Fr. Dave Pleier

A young farm boy accidentally overturned his wagon load of corn. The farmer who lived nearby heard the noise. "Hey Willis!" the farmer yelled. "Forget your troubles. Come in and eat with us. Then I'll help you get the wagon back up." "That's mighty nice of you," Willis answered, "but I don't think Pa would like me to." "Nonsense, come on in!" the neighbor insisted. "Well, ok," the little boy finally agreed, "but Pa won't like it."

After a hearty dinner, Willis thanked his host. "I feel a lot better now, but I know Pa is going to be upset." "Don't be foolish," the neighbor said with a smile. "And by the way, where is your Pa?" "Under the wagon!"

It's a stretch to fit a goofy joke with the readings or the Sunday celebration, but here goes. The question that haunts us all as Jesus is baptized, is "Why?" My sense is that Jesus wanted to affirm the ministry of John the Baptist, confirming his message that change was coming. Jesus would preach a whole new way of looking at life, what gives it meaning, what it means to be holy, etc. and John was getting the ball rolling. But some (and here's the tie-in} would rather stay under the wagon than join the banquet.

While some have no choice, others choose to not come in for the meal. Baptism joins us to the



community of believers and invites us to be an active part of that community, gathering regularly around the table. It is no secret that many of the baptized are not fed at the Table on weekends, and those who do scratch their heads and ask, "Why stay under the wagon?" Those who gather regularly are committed to living that new life Jesus proclaimed—forgiving, sharing, and simplifying—but for some, it is just easier to not change. But we who are here today and read these words remain hopeful and optimistic, inviting friends often to come in for dinner, no matter how entrenching the trap under which they are caught. To be nourished again today...what a aift!





Charitable Works of the Knights of Columbus Co. 1957

#### St. Hilary of Poitiers Bishop and Doctor of the Church | January 13

Born a pagan, St. Hilary studied philosophy and the meaning of life, eventually making his way through the bible. He became a convert and was appointed bishop of Poitiers in 353. Sometimes referred to as the Hammer of the Arians, St. Hilary defended the Nicene Creed against a popular heresy, Arianism. He was exiled to Phrygia for opposing Roman emperor Constantius II, who preferred the heresy which denies Christ's divinity. From Phyrgia St. Hilary fought with his pen, zealously writing against the heresy.

Eventually he was allowed to return to Poitiers, but did so by a circuitous route, preaching against Arianism all the way. St. Hilary was likely the first writer of hymns in the West, his writings on the Trinity, Psalms and Gospel of Matthew survive today. St. Hilary was created Doctor of the Church, a title given to those who provided important contributions to theology and doctrine, in 1851 by Pope Pius IX.
