

Father's Message

Thank God for the Apostle Thomas. We get great hope from the weakness of Jesus' own disciples. Thomas would not believe unless he saw for himself Jesus risen from the dead. Thomas had seen so many miracles, in fact he saw Jesus raise Lazarus from the dead just a few weeks before this scene in today's gospel. The "doubting" Thomas I am sure disappointed Jesus to some degree. It would be the same as putting the Lord to the test. Unless I see the nail holes I will not believe. How is that not putting the Lord to the test? Thank God for mercy and grace. That is what this reading with Thomas is about.



Jesus did not have to respond to Thomas' demands. He did it out of love and Thomas' ignorance. It isn't every day that one has risen from the dead, so Thomas was well within his rights to doubt, yet should he have? He was given that grace to follow Jesus. The best part in the gospel today is that Jesus pronounces blessing on us. Blessed are those who have not seen, but believe. That is us! That is the great news of the gospel. We believe, and we are 2000 years from the Christ event. That is a miracle in itself.

Generations upon generations of moms and dads, grandmas and grandpas have delivered the faith to their children, and then the Church itself has sustained it and kept the faith pure. The Roman Empire has come and gone. How many other government and societies no longer exist, yet here the tradition of the Church and the saints have been passed down without interruption. The Mass was first recorded in writing in the year 155 or so by Justin, the martyr in a defense of the faith to the Roman Emperor. He wrote about it like it was tradition for so long for them. It has not changed much since. We worship as the Apostle's taught us. Take a few moments to reflect on the miracle of the Church and what it took to bring it to our time. Only God can do such things!




