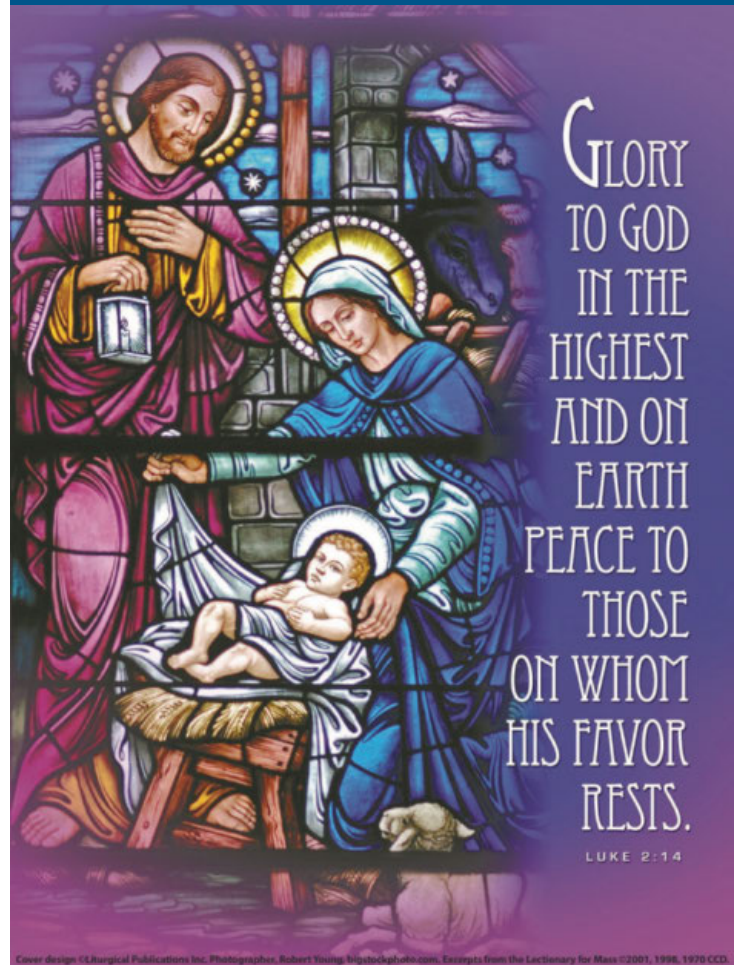

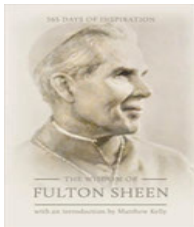

Thanks to you we were a huge success and were able to give Seton School \$1600 dollars from our profit. Seton School has taken this money to buy band instruments. What a gift!

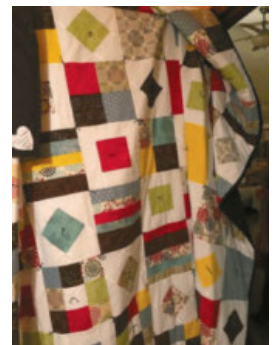
The winner of our beautiful queen size quilt we raffled was Lori Woelfel, Bookkeeper/Office Manager for our Sheboygan North Parishes.
