

## SHEBOYGAN COUNTY WARMING CENTER **MONTHLY OUTREACH - JANUARY 8/9**

The Warming Center is a group of inter-denominational churches, organizations, and friends joining together to provide an overnight shelter, dinner, and light breakfast for any adults during the cold winter months. The goal for the 2021-22 season is to be open from December 27-March 2022 from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. seven days a week. The Center is located in the basement of St. Cyril & Methodius Catholic Church. Due to Covid 19 concerns, there is a nightly capacity limit of 20 persons. The Warming Center is always looking for part-time staff to work nights, and volunteers to cover one of three shifts nightly on a rotating basis.

The money collected from our January Outreach Collection will be used to help with the nightly supplies that are needed such as pillows, blankets, cots, cleaning supplies, and food. 


"...They prostrated themselves and did him homage. Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh." – Mt 2:11
