

## Father's Message

When you only have a year to celebrate the most important life the universe has ever seen, we have to move fast. Since the birth of Christ, which we seemingly just celebrated, we reflected on a story of when He was twelve years old, then we celebrat-



ed His infancy again with the Magi, many other stories during the weekly gospel readings, and finally today, we end the Christmas season with the baptism of the Lord.

Of course, the baptism of the Lord is not an infancy narrative, but when Jesus was approximately thirty years old. Jesus' baptism is when we mark the beginning of ordinary time in the Church. Of course, there is nothing ordinary about Jesus. The intensity of His life would bring any normal person to their knees. The Christmas season is also a celebration that has three Sunday's in it, and its length in days depends on the length between Christmas and the first Sunday in Ordinary Time. This year, the Holy Family was celebrated the day after Christmas, so the season is the shortest it can be.

In contrast, the Easter Season is always fifty days long ending at Pentecost. That is the importance the Church places on the resurrection. Every Sunday is also a celebration of the resurrection so approximately 100 days are focused on the resurrection of the Lord. That is a long time to be in celebration of the resurrection but it is what makes life worth living.

As Christmas departs us, we move with great anticipation to our forty day penitential season and as always the resurrection of Easter Sunday. Time moves on the most eventful life in history. We rejoice always.




